SUBJECT: Appointment of Members to Ad Hoc Committee to Re-Evaluate Homestead Program

As a result of our recent assessment of our homesteading program, specifically, the agriculture homesteading program, it becomes apparent that an overall assessment of this program is essential. Therefore, the following individuals are hereby appointed to serve as members of an Ad Hoc Committee to re-evaluate our homesteading program:

1. Senator Edward DLG. Pangelinan - representing the Marianas Political Status
2. President Vicente N. Santos - representing the Marianas District Legislature
3. Mr. Daniel T. Muna - representing the Marianas District Land Advisory Board
4. Mr. Thomas Sheehan - District Planner, Marianas
5. Mr. Lester Weaver - District Agriculturist, Marianas
6. Mr. Elmer Gay - Acting District Land Management Officer, Marianas

The following are some guidelines for the Committee to use in its work:

1. To review the present homestead requirements and policies.
2. To review priorities.
3. To review the size of homestead and recommend what is a reasonable size for homestead.
4. To recommend a more stringent requirement for homesteaders to comply with.
5. To review the overall land availability and come up with a recommendation for proper and maximum utilization of the remaining lands available.
6. Other recommendations that the Committee may so choose to make.
