A small-unit amphibious exercise, nicknamed "Quick Jab" will be conducted on the Island of Tinian in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands, June 21-26 1974.

The purpose of the exercise is to train units of the <sup>Seventh</sup> ~~7th~~ Fleet in small-scale amphibious operations. Participating will be ~~1~~ U. S. Navy ships and approximately 200 ~~M~~ <sup>Marines</sup> of the Fleet Marine Force, U. S. <sup>Seventh</sup> ~~7th~~ Fleet. Four Marine Corps jet aircraft, temporarily located on Guam for the exercise, will also take part. The five days of training will be highlighted by the landing of a company of ~~M~~ <sup>Marines</sup> from an amphibious ship. The landing force will be supported by simulated naval gunfire. The exercise area and landing beaches will be restricted to specified military areas.
