THEIR APPLICATIONS HAVE BEEN SENT TO THE PROPER TRAVEL. DISTRICT ECONOMIC BOARDS FOR THEIR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION.

(FARMERS TOUR MARIANAS) SAIPAN, JULY 2 (UNS) --- THREE OF TRUK'S BEST FARMERS ENDED A 10 DAY INSPECTION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION IN THE MARIANAS TUESDAY (JULY 2). MICHEN HALLER, MAURICO ALIVIS, AND KINTARO FINE

STUDIED FARMING METHODS USED ON ROTA, TINIAN, AND SAIPAN UNDER THE AGRICULTURAL INPUT INCENTIVE PROGRAM. ACCORDING TO BERMIN WEILBACHER, CHIEF OF THE AGRICULTURE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, THE PROGRAM "SELECTS THE BEST FARMERS IN A DISTRICT AND SENDS THEM TO OTHER AREAS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY TO OBSERVE DIFFERENT FARMING METHODS."

THIS IS THE SECOND GROUP FROM TRUK TO TAKE PART IN THE PROGRAM. THE THREE WERE CHOSEN DURING THE ANNUAL TRUK FARMERS AND FISHERMAN'S FAIR HELD LAST MONTH.

THE GROUP WAS LED BY DAVID IVRA, AGRICULTURAL EXTENTION SUPERVISOR FOR TRUK.

THE FOUR RECEIVED EXCELLENT ASSISTANCE FROM THE PEOPLE IN THE MARIANAS AGRICULTURE STAFF, WEILBACHER SAID. "THE FARMERS WERE SO IMPRESSED BY THE SIZE AND FLATNESS OF SAIPAN'S FARMING LAND," HE COMMENTED, "THEY SAID THEY WANTED TO TAKE BACK THE FLAT LAND."

WEILBACHER SAID THAT FARMERS FROM YAP OR PALAU, OR PERHAPS ONE FROM EACH DISTRICT, WOULD BE SELECTED FOR THE NEXT EXCHANGE.

"IF I CAN FIND THE MONEY," VEILBACHER SAID, "I'D LIKE TO SEND A FARNER TO ANOTHER COUNTRY, FERHAPS TAIWAN, TO OBSERVE THEIR AGRICULTURAL METHODS."

SAIPAN, JULY 2 (NNS) --- JAMES MANGAFEL WANTS MORE BABIES.

MANGAFEL, MEMBER OF YAP'S DISTRICT LEGISLATURE,
INTRODUCED A RESOLUTION DURING ITS PRESENT SESSION
CALLING UPON "ALL PARENTS, BOYS AND GIRLS OF CHILD-BEARING
AGE IN (YAP)...TO DO EVERYTHING WITHIN THEIR POWER
AND ABILITY TO INCREASE THE POPULATION OF YAP."

HIS RESCLUTION EXPRESSED CONCERN OVER YAP'S SMALL FOPULATION IN RELATION TO THE OTHER FIVE TRUST TERRITORY DISTRICTS. "OUR SMALL POPULATION," THE RESOLUTION STATED, "HAS RENDERED US SOMEWHAT POLITICALLY IMPOTENT AND INEFFECTUAL IN OUR RELATIONS WITH OUR SISTER DISTRICTS ESPECIALLY WITH RESPECT TO OUR LOBBYING EFFORTS IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA."

THE POPULATION OF YAP DISTRICT IS ALMOST 8,000. TRUK'S POPULATION, IN COMPARISON, IS OVER 31,000. THE POPULATION OF THE MARIANA'S IS JUST OVER 13,000.

MANGAFEL'S RESOLUTION SAID THAT A YAPESÉ POPULATION BOOM WOULD "ENHANCE OUR POLITICAL POWER AND INFLUENCE IN MICRONESIA AND INCREASE THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL CAPACITY OF THIS DISTRICT FOR GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT."

COPIES OF THE RESOLUTION, MANGAFEL SAID, SHOULD BE SENT TO ALL YAPESE VILLAGE CHIEFS, HEADS OF HOUSEHOLDS, AND MINISTERS OF ALL RELIGIOUS SECTS, AMONG OTHERS.
