Main points:

- 2. Further ceiling increases not likely. In order to honor request (point 1), \$4.5 million of FY 1976 non-Marianas CIP projects must be deferred until FY 1977 and the power plant injected into the FY 1976 program.

3. The Department (DOI) will seek \$30,134,000 CIP funding in constant FY 1975 dollars in FY 1977 for all districts,

> This figure is arrived at by taking the six districts' \$31 million CIP figure contained in the three-year plan, minus \$5.366 million now programmed for the Marianas, then adding back the \$4.5 million lost in FY 1976.

- 4. Impact of \$4.5 million deferral will not be unduly restrictive; projects such as road building and paving are ongoing, and to have a portion of the money deferred would not substantially hinder the affected programs.
- 5. This entire matter with receive attention when Ambassador Williams meets with Senator Salii in July.
