The following misc. notes may be helpful in terms of "who does what" vis-a-vis Micronesia Affairs.

### State Offices

IO/UNP: John Kimball. Any issues involving UN.

PM/ISO: Jock Stoddart and Mort Dworkin. Any questions involving basing, exercises, strategic assignments.

EA/J: Bill Piez or Rust Demming. War Claims Agreement, TTPI/Japan relations.

SO/P: Brandon Grove. Staff Director, NCS Under Secretaries Committee. Has no substantive role, but all memoranda going through NSC Under Secretaries Committee flow through him and are coordinated in his office. Louise Froebe in his office is knowledgeable on mechanics.

UNA: Andre Surena. State lawyer handling Marianas Commonwealth negotiations.

Ron Stowe and Oliver "Tom" Johnson. They alternate in handling Free association compact negotiations. Both extremely knowledgeable on all substantive questions.

### Interior Department

DOTA - Stan Carpenter, Fred Radewagen (343-6971) or Jim Berg (343-4736) should routinely clear all message traffic to Saipan except that which is exclusively State business with Status LNO. Berg handles TTPI status question.

OMSN - Capt. Richard Scott, Office Director (343-9143), Ed Archer (343-9143), and Jim Wilson (343-9143) are primary contacts. Jim Wilson should not normally be bothered, except on major issues.

How to Telephone Alf Bergesen or David Schiele on Saipan

Saipan is in the same time zone as Sydney and Canberra -- with the consequent need to place calls in the late afternoon or evening out time. All calls should be made through the DOD "autovon" defense communications system, as follows:

- Call 695-9801 (Washington "Navy Switch")
- Ask for "Guam Operator" and for priority or immediate precedence.
- When you have Guam, ask for "Saipan Switch"; priority or Immediate.
- When you have Saipan, ask for Mr. Schiele or Mr. Bergesen. Until they have become well known, you may have to identify them as the Department of State officer who replaced Mary Vance Trent, etc.

Priortiy calls are often "preempted" by higher precedence calls, i.e. the connection will be suddenly broken, The only thing to do is to call again, or use a higher precedence. The moral to this story is to get through all of the important talk as soon as possible and leave gossip to the end.
