15-DAY SESSION WITH VERY LITTLE FLOOR ACTIVITY IN THE SENATE AND HOUSE FRIDAY (JULY 26).

IN THE SENATE, MARIANAS SENATOR OLYMPIU T. BURJA DELIVERED SHORT REMARKS SETTING OUT WHAT HE CONSIDERS TO BE MAJOR LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR THE SESSION (SEE FOLLOWING STORY). MOST OF THE WORK OF THE LAWMAKERS CONTINUES TO BE IN THE STANDING COMMITTEES DURING THE FIRST WEEK.

YAP'S SENATOR JOHN MANGEFEL OFFERED A BILL WHICH WOULD PROVIDE FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, (SB 354). THE BILL PROVIDES THAT THE MARSHALLS, TRUK AND PONAPE DISTRICTS INCREASE THEIR REPRESENTATIVES IN THE HOUSE BY ONE, WHILE REDUCING THE MARIANAS, AND PALAU DISTRICT BY ONE. YAP DISTRICT WOULD REMAIN THE SAME.

A JOINT RESOLUTION WAS INTRODUCED IN THE HOUSE URGING THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT "TO REQUEST THROUGH DIPLOMATIC CHANNELS, THAT THE PATHET LAO FORCES RELEASE PRISONER OF WAR EMMETT KAY, WHO PERFORMED NUMEROUS EMERGENCY MEDICAL EVACUATIONS IN MICRONESIA IN THE PAST, AND IS THE LAST KNOWN AMERICAN HELD PRISONER IN INDUCHINA," (HJR 136).

BOTH HOUSES WILL MEET AGAIN MONDAY MORNING AT 10:00 (JULY 29) WHICH WILL BE THE 7TH DAY OF THE 15-DAY SESSION. (PARA-MEDICS SAVE BOY)

SAIPAN, JULY 26 (MNS)---TWO U.S. AIR FORCE PARA-MEDICS PARACHUTED ONTO TOBI ISLAND IN SOUTHERN PALAU AND HAVE STABILIZED THE CONDITION OF A FIVE OLD BOY STRICKEN WITH PNEUMONIA.

ACCORDING TO LT. COMMANDER ALAN PENDLETON, MILITARY LIAISON OFFICER, THE TWO PARA-MEDICS WERE SENT FROM CLARK AIR FORCE BASE IN THE PHILIPPINES.

YOUNG MAN FROM TOBI WILL BE ALRIGHT."

THE BOY BECAME ILL ON JULY 5, PENDLETON REPORTED, AND HIS CONDITION BEGAN TO DETERIORATE RAPIDLY. HE ALSO CAME DOWN WITH INFECTION IN HIS INTESTINAL TRACT AND WAS UNABLE TO RETAIN WATER OR FOOD.

THE M/V JAMES COOK HEADED FOR TOBI FROM YAP, BUT IT DEVELOPED ENGINE TROUBLE AND HAD TO RETURN ON JULY 24. THE ONLY OTHER TRUST TERRITORY SHIP IN THE AREA, THE M/V HAFU ADAI, WAS DOCKED IN KOROR BUT ITS CREW WAS SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT AND A CAPTAIN WOULD HAVE HAD TO HAVE BEEN FLOWN IN FROM SAIPAN, PENDLETON SAID.

ACCORDING TO A DOCTOR ON TOBI, THE BOY REQUIRED IMMEDIATE EVACUATION TO KOROR'S MACDONALD HOSPITAL. THE MILITARY WAS ASKED, SAID PENDLETON, ABOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF REMOVING THE BOY BY HELICOPTER. HOWEVER, NO MILITARY

HELICOPTERS WERE AVAILABLE TO MAKE THE FLIGHT FROM THE PHILIPPINES TO TOBI.

THE PARA-MEDICS WERE FLOWN IN, PENDLETON SAID, AND WERE ABLE TO STABILIZE THE BOY'S CONDITION. THE M/V HAFU ADAI WILL PICK UP THE PARA-MEDICS AND BOY AND TAKE THEM TO KOROR, PENDLETON NOTED.

SAIPAN, JULY 26 (MNS)---THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE DEVELOPMENT BANK OF MICRONESIA WILL HOLD ITS FIRST MEETING ON TUESDAY (JULY 30) ON SAIPAN.

ACCORDING TO DEPUTY HIGH COMMISSIONER PETER T. COLEMAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD, THE DIRECTORS WILL MEET "TO REVIEW STAFF VACANCIES FOR THE BANK."

THEY WILL PRIMARILY REVIEW APPLICATION FOR THE POSITION OF GENERAL MANAGER, COLEMAN POINTED OUT. THE BANK BOARD HAS CONTACTED SEVERAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS TO SUBMIT POSSIBLE CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITION.

MICRONESIA" WHICH THE EDUCATION FOR SELF-GOVERNMENT (ESG)  
TASK FORCE HAS INITIATED. THE PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO BRING  
THE VIEWS OF LEADING OFFICIALS OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA,  
THE TRUST TERRITORY ADMINISTRATION, UNITED STATES AND  
MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATING TEAMS, AND OTHERS, WHICH ARE  
IMPORTANT TO THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA IN DECIDING THEIR  
FUTURE POLITICAL STATUS.

ALTHOUGH THE UN TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL DOES NOT LOOK  
FAVORABLY UPON THE SEPARATE MARIANAS TALKS, SENATOR  
PANGELINAN SAID THAT AFTER REVIEWING THE VARIOUS TERRITORIES  
THAT HAVE BEEN UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS, IT WAS DETERMINED  
THAT THERE ARE LEGAL JUSTIFICATIONS FOR THE NEGOTIATIONS.  
THE MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION FEELS VERY  
STRONGLY. PANGELINAN SAID, "THAT WE DO HAVE A LEGAL MANDATE  
NOT ONLY WITHIN THE TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT BUT ALSO FROM THE
