SENATE PRESIDENT TOSTWO NAKAYAMA OF TRUK AND HOUSE SPEAKER BETHWEL HENRY OF PONAME CALLED THEIR RESPECTIVE HOUSES TO ORDER AT ALMOST EXACTLY THE PRESCRIBED HOUR OF TEN A.M., BEFORE PACKED GALLERIES OF WITNESSES. THE SESSIONS WERE BRIEF AND FORMAL, ALTHOUGH IN THE SENATE ONE COMMITTEE WAS READY WITH A REPORT ON A BILL THAT LATER WAS PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING.

FROM THE FLOOR, PERMAPS SETTING THE STAGE FOR DEBATES TO COME
ON CURRENTLY SERIOUS PROBLEM AREAS. REPRESENTATIVE SASAUD HARUD
(TRUK) VOICED HIS CONCERN OVER THE RECENT FREIGHT RATE INCREASE
IMPOSED BY TRANSPACIFIC LINES, INC., SAYING IT WAS PUTTING A
PARTICULAR HARDSHIP ON MICRUNESIAN CONSUMERS.

"I THINK IT IS APPROPRIATE THAT THIS SESSION OF THE CONGRESS LOOK INTO THE MATTER SERIOUSLY," HARUO SAID, " AND, IF IT IS NOT OUT OF ORDER FOR MF TO SAY SO THIS MORNING, I WOULD LIKE TO ASK THE SPEAKER TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE HIGH COMMISSIONER TO SEE IFNITHIS ACTION BY TRANSPAC IS NOT A BREACH OF CONTRACT."

FOLLOWING THE SESSION, ANOTHER CONGRESS MEMBER SAID HE FEELS THE CONGRESS SHOULD PUT ASIDE ALL OTHER BUSINESS FOR THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF THE SESSION IN ORDER TO DEAL WITH THE PROBLEMS OF TRANSPAC.

ANOTHER TYPE OF SHIPPING PROBLEM WAS THE CONCERN OF REPRESENTATIVE JOHN HEINE (MARSHALLS). HE SAID HE RECENTLY COMPLETED A FIELD TRIP IN HIS DISTRICT. AND "EVERYWHERE WE SENT, WE FOUND OUT THAT THOSE ATOLLS AND ISLANDS HAVE NOT HAD A FIELD TRIP SHIP FOR OVER TEN MONTHS. NOW THAT THE PRICE OF COPRA IS VERY PROMISING," HEINE SAID, "IT IS USELESS TO ENCOURAGE PEOPLE TO MAKE COPRA WHEN THERE IS NO SHIP TO PICK IT UP FOR EXPORT."

DAY, AS ONE BILL MASSED SECOND AND FINAL READING AND WAS SENT TO THE HOUSE FOR CONSIDERATION. THE BILL IS ONE WHHICH RELATES TO BENEFITS TO MOVERUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS (SB 12) AND WOULD REQUIRE THE GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE REGULAR STIPENDS TO SUCH STUDENTS IF THE MUNETARY STIPENDS ARE ALSO PROVIDED TO PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN THE SAME DISTRICT. THE BILL, WHICH WAS OPPOSED BY THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, PASSED WITHOUT OPPOSITION, FOLLOWING A FAVERABLE COMMITTEE REPORT FROM THE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS CHAIRED BY SENATOR PETRUS TUN (YAP).

SENATE PRESTHENT TOSINO MAKAYAMA, IN A BRIEF OPENING COMMENT, SAID THE SESSION WILL BE DISCUSSING MANY IMPORTANT MATTERS RELATING TO THE PROBLEMS WHICH FACE MICRONESIA DURING THE NEXT FIFTY DAYS. THE PILOT WAS IDENTIFIED AS SERAFIN M. DELA CRUZ OF TINIAN, ONE OF THE FIRST MICRUNESIANS EVER TO OBTAIN A PILOT'S LICENSE AND PURCHASE HIS OWN AIRPLANF, DELA CRUZ OBTAINED THE SMALL CESSNA C=150 LATE LAST YEAR ON GUAM, AND BASED IT ON TINIAN, HE HAD MADE NUMEROUS FLIGHTS TO GUAT ISLANDD, A POPULAR HUNTING AND FISHING SPOT.

ACCORDING TO U.S. NAVY LIAISON OFFICER ON SAIPAN LT. COMMANDER ALAN R. PENDLETON, THE ACCIMENT WAS PROBABLY CAUSED BY THE HIGH WINDS OF TROPICAL STORM MANDA, WHICH PASSED NEAR GOAT ISLAND AND TINIAN SUNDAY. PENDLETON SAID REPORTS RECEIVED FROM THE PILOT VIA THE

PLANE'S RADIO, WHICH REMAINED IN OPERATING CONDITION AFTER THE CRASH,

INDICATED THAT BOTH HE AND HIS PASSENGER, IDENTIFIED ONLY AS PEDROCURZ, WERE INJURED. THE PASSENGER'S INJURIES WERE THE MOST SERIOUS.
