A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the Congress of Micromesia to appropriate the sum of \$250,000.00 to carry out the purposes of the homestead program in the Mariana Islands District.

WHEREAS, land is among the most important of the natural resources of the people of Micronesia; and

whereas, given the growing population of Micronesia, and the small hand area, as well as the importance of land for growing food, the importance of ownership of land becomes even greater; and

whereas, the Legislature, on behalf of the people of the Municipality of Saipan, expresses its gratitude to the Congress of Micronesia for the homestead program and for the designation of a considerable amount of land within the Municipality as homestead land; and

WHEREAS, despite the actions of the Congress of Micronesia, there are presently 1,370 applicants for homestead land; and

WHEREAS, the great backlog in processing applications for homesteads has arisen because of the lack of money to survey homestead sites and otherwise expedite the program; and

WHEREAS, the Saipan Legislature is without sufficient funds to provide for these purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Fourth Saipan Legislature, Third Regular Session, 1973, that the Congress of Micronesia is hereby respectfully urged and requested to appropriate the sum of Two Hundred and Fighty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) for the purpose of carrying out and expediting the homestend program in the Mariana Islands District; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Senate; to the Jpeaker of the House of Representatives; to the Chairman of the Senate Committees on Resources and Development and Ways and Means; to the Chairman of the House of Representative
