SAIPAN, JAN. 25 (MNS)---COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF-PACIFIC ADMIRAL NOEL GAYLOR WHOSE HEADQUARTERS IS IN HONOLULU, HAWAII, WILL BE ON SAIPAN SATURDAY (JAN. 26) MORNING FOR AN OFFICIAL COURTESY CALL TO HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON, ACCORDING TO LT. COMMANDER ALAN A. PENDLETON, CINCPAC REPRESENTATIVE FOR GUAM AND THE TRUST TERRITORY, MRS. GAYLOR IS ACCOMPANYING THE ADMIRAL ON THIS TRIP. ALSO ACCOMPANYING ADM. GAYLOR ARE MEMBERS OF HIS STAFF, INCLUDING REAR ADM. EARL YATES; MAJOR GENERAL EUGENE TIGHE; MR. JOHN KELLEY; AND MAJOR BRUCE BROWN, THE ADMIRAL'S ADMINISTRATIVE AIDE.

REAR ADMIRAL G.S. MORRISON, COMMANDER NAVAL FORCES MARIANAS, IS JOINING THE GROUP ON GUAM FOR THE SAIPAN TOUR. THE GROUP WILL BE MET AT THE AIRPORT BY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR FRANCISCO C. ADA AND HONOR GUARDS FROM THE SAIPAN POLICE FORCE.

FOLLOWING A LUNCHEON HOSTED BY HIGH COMMISSIONER JOHNSTON AT THE ROYAL TAGA HOTEL, THE GROUP WILL DEPART FOR A SHORT TOUR OF TINIAN AND THEN BACK TO GUAM WHERE ADM. GAYLOR AND HIS GROUP WILL TAKE OFF FOR A SPECIAL TRIP TO THE FAR EAST.

(MARIANAS CO-OPS CHARTERED)

SAIPAN, JAN. 25 (MNS)---HIGH-COMMISSIONER JOHNSTON THIS WEEK SIGNED CHARTERS FOR TWO FISHING COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATIONS FOR THE MARIANAS DISTRICT. THE ROTA FISHING CO-OP AND THE TINIAN FISHING CO-OP ARE THE FIRST TWO SUCH COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATIONS TO BE CREATED IN THE MARIANAS. THEIR FORMATION COMES AS A DIRECT RESULT OF THE FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1973, PUBLIC LAW 5-21.

WITH FORMATION OF THESE CO-OPS, IT IS NOW POSSIBLE TO PROCEED WITH THE FORMATION OF A MARIANAS DISTRICT FISHING AUTHORITY, THE ORGANIZATION WHICH CAN THEN TAKE ADVANTAGE OF CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA FISHING LOAN FUNDS AND OTHER PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED BY THE CONGRESS.

ACCORDING TO CREDIT UNION AND COOPERATIVE ADVISOR CHARES M. SICARD, CONSIDERATION IS CURRENTLY BEING GIVEN TO FORMATION OF A THIRD FISHING COOPERATIVE, THE SAIPAN FISHING COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION.

(MARIANAS YOUTH CORPS PROGRAM)

SAIPAN, JAN. 25 (MNS)---THE MARIANAS IS THE FIRST OF THE DISTRICTS PARTICIPATING IN THE YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS PROGRAM TO HAVE SUBMITTED THEIR PLAN FOR PROJECT FUNDING TO THE HEADQUARTERS DIVISION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, ACCORDING TO WILLIAM ALLEN, CHIEF OF THE DIVISION.

ALLEN SAID THAT TWO OF THE PROJECTS FOR YOUTH IN THE MARIANAS WILL BE COMBINED TO CREATE A MARKED NATURE TRAIL DOWN THE APPROACH TO BIRD ISLAND AND A SECOND TRAIL ALONG THE REEF SHELF OF BIRD ISLAND ITSELF. THE YOUTH WILL MARK BOTH TRAILS WITH SIGNS IN CHAMORRO, ENGLISH AND JAPANESE AND WILL POINT OUT THE FAUNA, FLORA AND GEOLOGICAL FEATURES OF THE AREA.

ACCORDING TO ALLEN, THE THIRD PROJECT IS TO CARRY OUT A HOUSE-TO-HOUSE WATER WASTAGE SURVEY USING A FORM DESIGNED BY THE DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH. HE ADDED THAT THE YOUTH WILL GIVE ASSISTANCE TO EACH HOUSEHOLD WHERE NECESSARY IN REPLACING FAUCET WASHERS.

ALLEN SAID THAT A SEPARATE TEAM OF EIGHT YCC ENROLLEES WILL WORK WITH ADULT CONSERVATION ADVISORS IN PREPARING RADIO, TELEVISION, AND PRINTED MATERIALS FOR USE IN THE SCHOOLS AND THE COMMUNITY TO EXPLAIN THE THREE PROJECTS AND ALERT MARIANAS RESIDENTS TO PRACTICAL MEASURES FOR CONSERVING NATURAL RESOURCES.

ACCORDING TO ALLEN THE PROJECTS ARE SCHEDULED TO BE CARRIED OUT THIS SUMMER. THE YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS PROGRAM IS SPONSORED BY THE HEADQUARTERS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DIVISION IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION, HEALTH SERVICES, PUBLIC WORKS, AGRICULTURE AND BROADCASTING. OTHER DEPARTMENTS AND COMMUNITY GROUPS ARE ALSO INVITED TO PARTICIPATE.
