2. (C) WHILE TURNOUTS ARE NOT ALWAYS LARGE, PROCEEDINGS ARE TAPED AND AIRED FOLLOWING DAY ON RADIO WHICH COVERS ALL MARIANAS. BROAD-CASTS SOMETIMES LAST AS LONG AS FIVE HOURS, AND SINCE PROCEEDINGS ARE IN THE THO LOCAL VERNACULARS THEY ARE INTELLIGIBLE TO EVERYBODY (I.E. ALL RESIDENTS OF MARIANAS) AND SEEM TO BE DRAWING WIDE AUDIENCE.
3. (C) IN RECENT CONVERSATIONS WITH U.S. DELEGATION MEMBERS PANGELINAN AND OTHER MPSC MEMBERS CAMACHO AND GUERRERO HAVE EXPRESSED

ENTHUSIASH ABOUT THE MEETINGS, PANGELINAN POINTS OUT THAT MPSC PROGRAM IS BRINGING THE IMPORTANT STATUS ISSUES TO THE PEOPLE. IN THIS CONNECTION HE EXPRESSED VIEW THAT PROSPECTIVE IT PROGRAM OF EDUCATION FOR SELF-GOVERNMENT DOES NOT REALLY MEET THE NEED. HE FEELS THAT PARAMOUNT NEED IS POLITICAL STATUS EDUCATION AND THAT ONLY THE STATUS NEGOTIATORS THEMSELVES ARE PROPER OR CREDIBLE INFOR-MANTS. WITH REGARD TO MARIANAS, HE TOLD DOTA OFFICER BERG THAT HE ENVISIONS A BILATERAL "COMMONHEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAM" AS SOON AS AGREEMENT IS CONCLUDED, AND SEES ROLE FOR A FULL-TIME U.S. CITIZEN IN THIS EFFORT. HE ASSO COMMENTED THAT STATUS POLITICAL EDUCATION HOULD NECESSARILY OVER AP SUCH OTHER POLITICAL EDUCATION DURING TRANSITION PERIOD AS THAT RELATING TO MARIANAS CONSTITUTION. (C) IN FURTHER CONVERSATION WITH BERG (JAN 26) PANGELINAN COM-MENTED ON VIEWS OF CAROLINIAN SECTOR OF MARIANAS POPULATION. HE SAID THE CAROLINIANS ARE WARY ABOUT BECOMING U.S. CITIZENS. APPAR-ENTLY THEY FEEL THAT THIS WOULD TEND TO LUMP THEM TOGETHER WITH THE NORE NUMEROUS CHARMORROS IN THE EYES OF THE U.S. AND THUS CAUSE THEM TO LOSE THEIR IDENTITY. THEY ARE ALSO CONCERNED FOR THE FATE OF CAROLINIANS WHO WORK IN AND AROUND IT HEADQUARTER. PANGELINAN SAID THAT THE MAJORITY OF MARIANAS CITIZENS WHO WORK AT HEADQUARTERS ARE

CAROLINIAN. HE SAID THAT HE ANSHERED THIS CONCERN BY SAYING IT WAS HIS UNDERSTANDING THAT NEW EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES WOULD BE AVAILABLE IN THE MARIANAS COMMONHEALTH GOVERNMENT, ON TINIAN, ETC. THIS INFORM TION SEEMED, HE SAID, I ALLEVIATE SOME OF THEIR CONCERN. THE CAROLINIAN RELUCTANCE AS I U.S. CITIZENSHIP, HE FEELS. GOES TO THE MEART OF THE MATTER: THE ASSUMPTION THAT THERE WILL MALHAYSH BE THO PEOPLES IN THE MARIANAS. HE SAID HIS PERSONAL FEELING IS THAT THE DIFFERENCES WILL VANISH OVER TIME BUT HE IS NOT SO SURE THAT THE CAROLINIANS AND SOME CHAMDROS BELIEVE THIS OR DESIRE IT.
