"YET IT IS JUST THIS PART OF THE POPULATION IN WHICH NATIONAL ECONOMIES ARE OFTEN MAINLY BASED, SO IMPAIRED PRODUCTIVITY DUE TO ILL HEALTH OF THE RURAL WORKER HAS VERY SEVERE EFFECTS ON THE NATION AS A WHOLE," DR. DY STATED.

BUT PROGRAMS TO PROVIDE HEALTH COVERAGE TO THE ENTIRE COULATION ARE FACED WITH NUMEROUS CONSTRAINTS, AMONG WHICH IS

THE LACK OF SUFFICIENT HEALTH PERSONNEL.

RURAL COMMUNITIES, ON THE OTHER HAND, DO NOT NEED MUCH SOPHISTICATED MEDICAL CARE FACILITIES, AND "THE MAJORITY DO HEALTH PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED THERE ARE OF A COMPARATIVELY SIMPLE NATURE NOT REQUIRING REFINED DIAGNOSTIC AND THERAPEUTYS ARMAMENT," DR. DY SAID.

"MOREOVER, THE MAJORITY OF HEALTH PROBLEMS IN TODAY'S RURAL COMMUNITIES ARE PREVENTABLE DISEASES WHICH CAN BE TACKLED SUCCESSFULLY BY METHODS WHOSE APPLICATION DOES NOT REQUIRE THE HIGHEST DEGREE OF SCIENTIFIC KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL," CONTINUED OR. DY.

IN A LETTER TO HIGH CUMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON, THE COMMITTEE EXPRESSED ITS APPROVAL OF JUAN A.
