**LADY WINS CONGRESS SEAT)

MAJURO, NOV. 6 (MNS) -- VOTERS IN THE MARSHALL ISLANDS HAVE APPARENTLY ELECTED THE FIRST WOMAN TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA. BASED ON EARLY AND INCOMPLETE RETURNS, CARMEN MILNE BIGLER APPEARED TO HAVE DEFEATED INCUMBENT FRESHMAN CONGRESSMAN JOHN HEINE AND CHUJI CHUTARO.

AFTER HORKING ALL NIGHT IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE ON MAJURO, THE COUNTING AND

TABULATION COMMITTEE, HEADED BY FRED SIGRAH, REPORTED THAT
MS, BIGLER HAD AMASSED A HUGE LEAD ON MUJURO ATOLL AND
FROM ABSENTEE BALLOTS, ALTHOUGH RETURNS FROM ARNO AND MILI AND
THE OTHER ATOLLS THAT MAKE UP REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT FIVE
WERE NOT IN EARLY WEDNESDAY MORNING (NOV. 6), IS APPEARED
TO MOST OBSERVERS THAT MS, BIGLER WAS THE WINNER.

IN OTHER RACES IN THE MARSHALLS, INCUMBENTS WERE RUNNING STRONG, IT APPEARED THAT SENATOR AMATA KABUA WOULD RETAIN HIS SEAT BY A MARGIN OF ABOUT TWO TO ONE OVER CHALLENGER CARL HEINE, AND INCUMBENTS CHARLES DOMNICK, ATAJI BALOS AND EKPAP SILK WERE RUNNING WELL AHEAD IN EARLY RETURNS FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE DISTRICTS.

A FINAL COUNT WILL BE DELAYED, HOWEVER, BECAUSE IN THE KWAJALEIN ATOLL, INCLUDING HEAVILY POPULATED EBEYE, WERE GOING TO THE POLLS WEDNESDAY, KNAJALEIN FOLLOWS HAWAII TIME, AND IT THUS AFFECT THE BILER-HEINE-CHUTARO RACE, THOUGH.

THE FINAL, UNOFFICIAL TOTALS FOR ABSENTEE VOTES, PLUS BALLOTS CAST IN MAJURO, SHOWED MS. BIGLER WITH 593, HEINE RUNNING FAR BEHIND IN SECOND PLACE WITH 189, AND CHUTARO IN THIRD WITH 141, A HANDFUL OF VOTES WAS ALSO CAST FOR HEMOS

MID-MORNING WEDNESDAY, RETURNS FROM THE OTHER RACES WERE.

SCATTERED AND VERY INCOMPLETE.
MS. BIGLER, THE WIFE OF NOEL BIGLER, WHO WORKS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE MARSHALLS, RAN AN ASTUTE, AMERICA-STYLE CAMPAIGN THAT INCLUDED SATURATING THE DISTRICT CENTER WITH BUMPER STICKERS, BUTTIONS AND NEWSPAPER ADVERTISEMENTS AND POSTERS, SHE WILL BE THE FIRST WOMAN EVER TO SIT IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, ALTHOUGH WOMEN HAVE HELD SEATS IN SOME OF THE TERRITORY'S DISTRICT LEGISLATURES.

OBSERVERS POINTED OUT THAT MS. BIGLER'S LEAD IN MAJURO WOULD PROBABLY BE INSURMOUNTABLE, EVEN IF BOTH ARNO AND MILI GO AGAINST HER. THERE ARE 303 REGISTERED VOTERS IN MILI, WHERE CHUTARO IS EXPECTED TO PICK UP A GOOD SHARE OF THOSE VOTES. NOT ALL OF THE REGISTERED VOTERS ACTUALLY VOTED, OF COURSE, MAKING MS. BIGLER'S LEAD OF MORE THAN 400 VOTES IN

RETURNS ARE STILL UNOFFICIAL UNTIL CERTIFIED BY THE ELECTION COMMISSIONER, AND REPORTS FROM SOME OF MAJURO'S OUTER ISLANDS MAY TAKE A FEW DAYS, EARLY INDICATIONS WERE THAT MORE VOTERS WERE TURNING OUT TO VOTE IN THIS ELECTION, ONE OF THE CLOSER AND MORE INTERESTING ELECTIONS HELD IN THE MARSHALLS IN RECENT VEARS.

(PALAU, MARIANAS, PONAPE, TRUK ELECTION RETURNS) SAIPAN, NOV. 6 (MNS) -- ELECTIONS FOR THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA WERE CONDUCTED TUESDAY (NOVEMBER 5). AND FROM RESULTS REPORTED BY THE VARIOUS DISTRICT ELECTION COMMISSIONERS, IT APPEARS AS THOUGH THERE WILL BE SEVERAL NEW FACES IN THE TERRITORY'S HIGHEST ELECTIVE BODY, FROM UNOFFICIAL FIGURES SUPPLIED BY THE HEADQUARTERS LEGISLATIVE LIAISON DIVISION, TWO INCUMBENT SENATORS AND SEVEN INCUMBENT MEMBERS OF THE

HOUSE FO REPRESENTATIVES ARE LOOSING IN THEIR BIDS FOR REELECTION. THE RESULTS ARE STILL SUBJECT TO FINAL CERTIFICATION BY THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS.

FROM THE MARIANAS DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVE 1., INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN FELIPE Q. ATALIG HAS BEEN DEFEATED IN HIS THIRD BID FOR A TWO YEAR TERM BY MARIANAS POLICE CAPTAIN JOSE P. MAFNAS MAFNAS GARNERED 545 VOTES TO ATALIG'S 254 VOTES, HERMAN PALACIOS, POPULAR PARTY CANDIDATED, CAME IN SECOND WITH 403 VOTES, JOSEPH INDS TALLIED 91 VOTES, MAFNAS TOOK SAN ANTONIO VILLAGE, CONSIDERED A POPULAR PARTY STRONGHOLD BY COLLECTING 253. HE ALSO TOOK ROTA, A TERRITORIAL PARTY STRONGHOLD GARNERING 195 VOTES, HE LOST ON TINIAN, THOUGH BY A CLOSE MARGIN.

IN REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT 2, INCLUDING ALL CHALAN KANDA, FORMER CAA EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR HERMAN R. GUERRERO LEADS BY 13 VOTES OVER INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN PEDRO P. TENORIO. GUERRERO HAS 540 VOTES TO TENORIOIS 527. ABSENTEE BALLOTS HAVE NOT BEEN COUNTED YET.

REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT 3 VOTES HAVE NOT BEEN COUNTED PENDING THE ACTUAL VOTING BY RESIDENTS IN THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS, REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT 3 INCLUDES THE NORTHERN PART OF SAIPAN AND ALL OF THE NORTHERN ISLANDS.

THE SENATORIAL RACE ALSO IS STILL INCOMPLETE PENDING THE ELECTION RESULTS IN THE NORTHERN ISLANDS. POLITICAL OBSERVERS

IN THE SENATORIAL RACE BETWEEN INCUMBENT SENATOR ROMAN TMETUCHL AND JOHN O. NGIRAKED, TMETUCHL IS LEADING WITH 792. NGIRAKED HAS 650 VOTES.

IN PONAPE DISTRICT, INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN JOAB SIGRAH: HAS DEFEATED YOSIWO GEORGE IN A CLOSE RACE FOR REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT DISTRICT NO. 12. HE RECEIVED 1,420 VOTES.

INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN RESTO MOSES DEFEATED HEINRICH IRLARTE AND PETER M. CHRISTIAN BY A WIDE MARGIN IN REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT 13, CONGRESSMAN MOSES TALLIED 1,143, IRTARTE HAS 390 AND CHRISTIAN COLLECTED 316 VOTES.
