CABLE READS - MPSC VICE CHAIRMAN SANTOS REQUESTS FOLLOWING MESSAGE
BE PASSED TO AMBASSADOR WILLIAMS AND HOWARD WILLENS

"CONFERRED WITH PETE TENORIO AND FELIX RABULIMAN TODAY. THEY
ALSO DECIDED IN FAVOR OF MEETING OF STATUS NEGOTIATORS FOR 2 DECEMBER
AS SCHEDULED. REASON THEY WERE NOT INCLUDED IN PREVIOUS DISPATCH
WAS THAT THEY WERE OFF ISLANDS AT THAT TIME. REASON FELIPE SALAS
NOT INCLUDED IN LIST WAS HIS RESIGNATION FROM STATUS COMMISSION TO
ACCEPT POSITION AS DISTRICT COURT JUDGE. I CONTACTED DR. PALACIO
AS TO WHETHER HE DESIRED MEETING OF STATUS NEGOTIATORS FOR DECEMBER 2.
HE INDICATED HE WILL CALL BACK TO LET ME KNOW HIS POSITION BUT HAS
NOT DONE SO.
