

(TRUK FINAL RESULTS IN)

SAIPAN, NOV. 25 (MNS) ⁷⁴—TWO MORE INCUMBENTS FROM TRUK DISTRICT HAVE LOST THEIR SEATS IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA. THE LATEST CASUALTIES ARE SENATOR ANDON AMARIACH, AND CONGRESS MAN MASAO NAKAYAMA.

COMPLETE BUT UNOFFICIAL RESULTS FROM THE WESTERN ISLANDS AND NOMONUITO ATOLL WERE RECEIVED OVER THE WEEKEND BY THE OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE LIAISON, SHOWING THAT SENATOR AMARIACH GAINED 621 VOTES TO NICK BOSSY'S 151, BUT IT WAS NOT ENOUGH TO OVERCOME BOSSY'S LEAD.

FINAL FIGURES SHOWS THAT NICK BOSSY RECEIVED 6,382 VOTES TO SENATOR AMARIACH'S 6,006, A DIFFERENCE OF 376 VOTES.

IN THE 18TH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT, INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN MASAO NAKAYAMA LOST HIS SEAT TO LAMBERT AAFIN IN A THREE-WAY RACE. AAFIN RECEIVED 609 VOTES TO NAKAYAMA'S 451. THE OTHER CANDIDATE, MASACHIRO CHRISTLIB TALLIED 198 VOTES.

THE OTHER TWO INCUMBENTS WHO LOST THEIR SEATS IN TRUK ARE: HOUSE VICE-SPEAKER ENDY DOIS, WHO LOST TO CHIRO ALBERT, AND CONGRESSMAN MACHIME O'SONIS, WHO WAS BEATEN BY KALISTO REFONOPEI.

THE RESULTS FROM TRUK ARE STILL UNOFFICIAL UNTIL CERTIFIED BY THE ELECTION COMMISSIONER, WHO IS THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR. (NOTE: A COMPLETE LIST OF ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA FROM ALL SIX DISTRICTS IS INCLUDED IN TODAY'S MNS DISPATCH).

(HEINE RECOUNT DENIED)

MAJURO, NOV. 25 (MNS)---INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN JOHN R. HEINE, WHO LOST HIS SEAT TO THE ONLY WOMAN CANDIDATE IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA GENERAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 5TH, HAS BEEN DENIED HIS REQUEST FOR A RECOUNT BY THE ELECTION BOARD IN THE MARSHALLS.

ACCORDING TO A SPOKESMAN FOR THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, MARSHALLS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR OSCAR DEBRUM, WHO IS ALSO THE ELECTION COMMISSIONER, HAS INFORMED CONGRESSMAN HEINE THAT NONE OF THE REASONS CITED IN HIS PETITION WARRANTED A RECOUNT.

CONGRESSMAN HEINE LOST HIS SEAT TO MS. CARMEN M. BIGLER IN A THREE-WAY RACE. MS. BIGLER RECEIVED 729 VOTES TO HEINE'S 372. THE OTHER CANDIDATE, CHUJI CHUTARO, TALLIED 276.

MS. BIGLER WILL BE THE FIRST CONGRESSWOMAN IN THE HISTORY OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA.

HEINE FILED HIS PETITION FOR RECOUNT TUESDAY (NOV. 19), THE DEADLINE FOR FILING ANY PETITION FOR A RECOUNT OR COMPLAINTS OF ELECTION IRREGULARITIES.

(MOSES, REMELIIK RETURN FROM AUSTRALIA VISIT)

MARSHALLS, NOV. 25 (MNS)---CONGRESSMAN RESIO MOSES OF PONAPE AND PALAU DEPUTY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR HARUO REMELIIK RECENTLY RETURNED TO THE TRUST TERRITORY FROM WHAT THEY DESCRIBED AS "A MOST SUCCESSFUL TRIP" TO AUSTRALIA.

REMELIIK SAID "THE TRIP WAS VERY INFORMATIVE, EDUCATIONAL," AND HE HOPES THAT "SUCH TRIPS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO OTHER MICRONESIANS ON A CONTINUING BASIS."

MOSES AND REMELIIK WERE INVITED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF AUSTRALIA TO TOUR THAT COUNTRY, SIMILAR TO THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT LEADER GRANT TOURS. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THEY WERE THE FIRST MICRONESIANS TO VISIT AUSTRALIA UNDER SUCH AN OFFICIAL ARRANGEMENT.

THEIR BIDS FOR RE-ELECTION FOR THE SIXTH CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA.
