This Long Range Capital Improvement Plan as presented here is a major step toward developing and identifying program goals and directions for the improvement and development of Ponape District. Projects outlined in this plan are ambitious and may seem impractical from a Trust Territory budgetary stand point. However, we feel that this presentation will cast some light on the hard realities of this District needs in many areas that remain to be developed. It also indicates that much of our responsibilities are not being carried out. We have moved rather slowly in these past years, almost at a snail's pace because of our limited resources.

Studies after studies have been carried out in many areas for these islands and it is common knowledge that almost all recommended accelleration in our developmental efforts have encountered resistance. Open criticisms for our failures to carry out these recommendations are too common and are heard throughout Micronesia and elsewhere. In these pages, we are again reiterating what those studies have revealed and our own strong confirmation that we have many vital needs hitherto unmet and unfulfilled.

Our anticipated increased ceilings in FY 1976 - 1980 is a welcome news to us all. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all who have, one way or another, make this move possible.

We can say now that the time has come when we can begin to move toward implementing our objectives. We in the Ponape District feel just that. We are ready to get our programs moving.
