A GRAND PRIZE OF 975 WILL BE AWARDED FOR THE BEST ESSAY CHOSEN FROM AMONG TWELVE TOP SELECTIONS SCREENED ON A TERRITORY-WIDE BASIS, TWO TOP ESSAYS WILL BE SELECTED FROM EACH DISTRICT TO COMPETE FOR THE GRAND PRIZE OF \$75. A PRIZE OF \$50 WILL BE AWARDED FOR THE TOP ESSAY IN EACH DISTRICT AND SECOND PLACE WINNERS WILL RECEIVE \$25.

THE ESG TASK FORCE AT THE HEADQUARTERS ON SAIPAN WILL MAKE THE FINAL SELECTION FOR THE GRAND PRIZE OF \$75, AS WELL AS JUDGING THE BEST ESSAYS SUBMATTED FROM THE DISTRICTS FOR FIRST AND SECOND PRIZES.
