

MEMORANDUM FOR THE MARIANAS PUBLIC LAND CORPORATION FILE

Subject: Telcon with Senator Pangelinan (February 14, 1974)

The Chairman reported that the TTPI Bill was introduced a few days ago and that hearings are scheduled on both bills for Saturday, February 16. He does not expect, however, any bill to pass the Congress of Micronesia until the last possible date - March 13. At my my request, the Chairman will confirm the exact closing date of the Marianas District Legislature. I told him that it was very important that we try to get the District Legislature to pass the enabling legislation and establish the land corporation before next August. He said that he would let me know what the possibilities are regarding a recess or a special session of the District Legislature. I repeated that I was willing to go to Saipan either in the second week of March or try to handle this matter in connection with the preparation for negotiations in late April or May.
