1 and requirements of Micronesia, and would therefore not be adequate  
2 compensation for the rights and privileges proposed to be given to the  
3 United States under the terms of the Draft Compact of Free Association;  
4 now, therefore,

5 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, Fifth Congress of Micronesia, Second  
6 Regular Session, 1974, the House of Representatives concurring, that  
7 it is the position of the Congress of Micronesia that no future arrangement  
8 with the United States will be acceptable to the Congress unless it  
9 contains provisions for the future financial support of Micronesia of at  
10 least \$80,000,000 per year in grants for operations and capital improve-  
11 ment projects, or in the alternative, if the United States is unable to  
12 provide financial support at this level, unless the proposed arrangement  
13 provides for United States authority in foreign affairs and defense matters  
14 significantly reduced from that which is presently contained in the  
15 provisions of the Draft Compact; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Joint Committee on Future Status is  
17 directed to continue negotiations with the United States on the condition  
18 that progress is made toward a satisfactory agreement on future financial  
19 support based on the position of the Congress of Micronesia as set forth  
20 in this Resolution; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this Resolution be  
22 transmitted to the Chairman of the Joint Committee on Future Status and to  
23 the President's Personal Representative for Micronesian Status Negotiations.
