I and requirements of Micronesia, and would Planeture not be adequate 2 compensation for the rights and privileges proposed to be given to the 3 United States under the terms of the Draft Compact of Free Association; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate, Fifth Congress of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1974, the House of Representatives concurring, that 7 it is the position of the Congress of Micronesia that no future arrangement With the United States will be acceptable to the Congress unless it contains provisions for the future financial support of Micronesia of at 16 least \$80,000,000 per year in grants for operations and capital improve-11 ment projects, or in the alternative, if the United States is unable to 12 provide financial support at this level, unless the proposed arrangement 13 provides for United States authority in foreign affairs and defense matters 14 significantly reduced from that which is presently contained in the 15 provisions of the Draft Compact; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Joint Committee on Future Status is directed to continue negotiations with the United States on the condition that progress is made toward a satisfactory agreement on future financial
