Dear Sirs:

It is with honor and pleasure we extend to you and the Congress of Micronesia the invitation of the people of the Marshalls District to hold a Special Session in Majuro, should it be the desire of the Congress to hold such a Special Session this year. We support House Joint Resolution No 78 now pending before the House of Representatives.

We would suggest that the time of holding the Special Session be during the Summer, June or July, when the facilities of the Marshall Islands High School---living accommodations, kitchen, etc., will be available for use by the Congress. This will assist us with the limited hotel accommodations we have at the present time.

We may need some funds to defray the cost of installing additional telephone lines, power, office space for the members and the staff. This fund will be in the neighborhood of \$40,000.00. We feel that we can scrape up \$10,000.00 if the Congress can provide the additional \$30000.00. We will do our best to accommodate the Congress and we recommend the appointment of someone from the Congress to coordinate plans with my office and the Legislature and the leaders of the Marshalls.
