AN CHITMANCE TO AUTHORIZE A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE PARTECIPALITY OF TIMIAN ON SUMMAY APRIL 7, 1974, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMBUCTING A SPECIAL POLL TO PERMIT VOTERS TO EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS AND VISIES ON THE ISSUE OF THE EXTENT OF U.S. MILITARY OCCUPANCY ON THE ISLAND OF TIMIAN AND ANOTHER.

EN TY ENACTED BY THE TWELFTH TINIAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, THAT:

Saction 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Ordinance is to ascertain the current wishes, attitudes, and desires of the inhabitants of the Municipality of Tinian relative to the extent of United States Military occupancy of the Island of Tinian; more specifically:

- (a) Their views on the relocation of the village of San Jose and.
- (b) The land area to be occupied by said United States
  Military, all in consonance with the basic rights
  outlined in Article 6 of the Trusteeship Agreement
  for the former Japanese Mandated Islands, by
  holding a Special Poll

Section 2. Special Poll. There shall be held throughout the surficipality of Tinian, a Special Poll for the purpose of submitting to all the persons residing within the sunicipality and who are eligible to work under the requirements of the Municipal Election Law, Certain questions to accertain their views attitudes and preferences. Said Special Poll shall be held on Sunday April 7, 1974, and the District Administrator is requested to issue a proclamation calling such Special Poll for such date, to be held to execute with the election laws of the Hamicipality of Tiniah and the

Section 4. Results of Poll. The Special Poll authorized by this Ordinance shall be conducted in a manner similar to elections insofar as such provisions may be applicable. The results of such poll shall be certified to the Election Commissioner and to the High Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands.

Saction 5. <u>Appropriation</u>. There is hereby authorized to be appropriated out of any unobligated surplus in the General Fund of the Namicipality of Tinian the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) or as much thereof as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this

ordinanca.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, Municipality of Tinian, and the District Administrator, Mariana Islands District, or upon its becoming law without such approval. Passed and adopted this 14 th day of Teles 1974.
