Meet Set On TransPac

SAIPAN (MNS) -- Trust Territory High Commissioner Edward E. Johnston and Office of Territorial Affairs Director Stanley S. Carpenter will meet in Honolulu Thursday and Friday to discuss the shipping situation in Micronesia and the condition of TransPacific Lines.

The HiCom said he requested the meeting, since he was due to be in Honolulu anyway during the next few days to attend a

meeting of the Pacific Islands Development Corporation (PIDC) beginning Feb. 11.

"We have asked for this meeting with Interior Department officials because of our mutual great concern over the TransPac situation, and because of the concern expressed in recent weeks by the members of the Congress of Micronesia," the HiCom said.
