in public opinion.

3. Conclusions:

- a. Recent events have created additional political obstacles to an early DOD Palau Land Survey.
- b. From the DOD point of view, as indicated in the 15 Feb Scott memorandum, the earlier the survey the better.
- c. If future talks are delayed, it would be unnecessary to stir the political pot with a survey at this time, and therefore prudent to await the resolution of some of these political issues.
- d. However, if an early date is decided for the next round of status talks, an early survey will be necessary to provide OMSN basic information required for the negotiations.

4, Recommendation:

That this problem be discussed with the Chairman, JCFS and only if a new round of talks are scheduled this summer should pressure be applied for an early survey.
