

## ANNEX C

- (a) The Governments of Micronesia and of the United States, and the heads of their respective Resident Offices, shall be exempt from all national, regional or municipal dues and taxes in respect of the premises of their respective Resident Offices, whether owned or leased, other than such as represent payment for specific services rendered.
- (b) Any person employed by the Government of Micronesia in its Resident Office who is neither a citizen nor a permanent resident of the United States, or any person employed by the Government of the United States in its Resident Office who is neither a citizen nor a permanent resident of Micronesia shall be exempt from income and social security taxes levied under the laws of the host Government with respect to income which is paid from funds provided by the employing Government or any agency thereof and upon which they are subject to the income or social security tax laws of the employing Government or any other Government and from taxes on the purchase, ownership, use or disposition of personal

movable property (including automobiles) intended for their own use. Such employees and members of their families shall receive the same treatment with respect to the payment of customs and import and export duties on personal effects, equipment and supplies imported into the territory of the other Government for their own use, and with respect to other duties and fees, as is accorded by the Government of the United States to diplomatic personnel of foreign countries resident in the United States, subject only to the limitation that continuous customs free entry shall be limited to personnel, including their families, of comparable grade to the diplomatic personnel accorded continuous customs free entry by the United States.

- (c) The premises of the Resident Offices shall be inviolable. Neither the agents of the Government of Micronesia nor those of the Government of the United States may enter the premises of the other Government's Resident Office except with the consent of the head of that Resident Office.
- (d) The premises of each Government's Resident Office,
  their furnishings and other property thereon and the
  means of transport of the Resident Office shall be
  immune from search, requisition, attachment or execution, except

insofar as such immunity is expressly waived by the head of the Resident Office or someone authorized to act on his behalf.

(e) Any person employed by either the Government of Micronesia or the Government of the United States in its Resident Office who is also a citizen of the employing Government shall enjoy immunity from the criminal jurisdiction of the other Government. This immunity shall extend to all members of the family of such a person forming part of his household, if they are not citizens of the receiving Government.
