

Dear Mr. Helfer:

This is in response to your letter of February 27, 1974, to Mr. Robert Prosek, requesting statistical information relating specifically to Guam.

This Service is unable to provide the detailed data that you require. The statistics presented in the eight annual report tables mentioned in your letter are available only as they apply to the entire United States; they are not collected for any State or U.S. territory or possession. Several tables from the annual report that do contain data related to your request are enclosed.

Each January, aliens present in the United States are required by law to report their addresses to this Service. The copies of Table 35 show the number of aliens who reported addresses during January of the past two years, by selected nationalities and State or territory of residence. The alien population of each State and territory, for the years 1940, 1960, and 1969 through 1973, is provided in Table 36.

The number of immigrants admitted in fiscal years 1972 and 1973, by specified countries of birth and place of intended residence (including U.S. territories and possessions) is presented in the copies of Table 12A.

Data on nonimmigrants admitted at Agana, Guam, during the past two years is contained in the copies of Tables 17A, 17B, and 17C. The number of temporary visitors and other nonimmigrants admitted, by port, is presented in Table 17A. Tables 17B and 17C show the country of last permanent residence of temporary visitors admitted at, respectively, airports and seaports. The number of foreign laborers admitted or paroled into this country during each year of the past decade is shown in Table 18.

Although the Service cannot supply the precise data that you desire, it is hoped that the information provided will be of assistance to you.
