Subj: Carnegie Project Interview

At a lunch I had with two staff members of the Carnegie Endowment Micronesia Project last week, I learned that Don McHenry, director of the project, is quite anxious to meet with you for an on-record discussion of status negotiations and related subjects. To my knowledge, McHenry has not yet formally requested an appointment, but would probably welcome an indication from us that such a meeting is possible.

McHenry and his staff have interviewed a wide range of organizations and individuals involved in Micronesian matters and OMSN should certainly be heard from in the project final report. Accordingly, I would recommend that you agree to meet with McHenry when he requests an appointment which is likely to occur within the next week or two. If you find this recommendation acceptable I would like to advise the Carnegie staff.
