

# COM Picks U.N. Reps

SAIPAN (MNS) --The Congress of Micronesia has selected Sen. Wilfred Kendall of Marshalls and Rep. Joab Sigrah of Ponape to accompany the High Commissioner to this year's meeting of the U.N. Trusteeship Council in New York. The meeting begins May 28.

The congress also voted late in its recently-completed session to select Marshalls Sen. Amata Kabua as its representative to the 14th South Pacific Conference this year. Rep. Sasauo Haruo of Truk was selected by the house to accompany Kabua.

Last year, Sen. Anclon Amaraich of Truk attended the UN with Sigrah. Following this practice of sending one new member with one of the two who attended the previous year, Sigrah was selected again along with Kendall.

Haruo was the congressional delegate to the SPC last year. He is chairman of the house Committee on Resources and Development, while Kabua chairs the same committee in the senate.

The TT administration also has announced that Truk District Administrator Juan Sablan will accompany the High Commissioner to the UN meeting this year as a special advisor.
