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Standard Research Consultants, Inc. were hired six years ago to do some projections on population for Guam's future. Some of it is guesswork, of course, and some of it was updated for the 1970 census where somehow we lost about 13,000 people. They claim that by this year, 1974, we're supposed to have 110,000 people, including 33,000 military, 60,000 Guamanians, 7,000 Statesiders, 6,000 Filipinos and 3,700 other. By 1980, these seers claim, Guam will have 140,000 people, including 41,000 military, 77,000 Guamanians, 9,000 statesiders, 8,000 Filipinos, and 5,000 others.
