MEMORANDUM TO THE MPSC FILE

Re: _ Immigration

Mr. Prosek of the Immigration Service called today to say that he had found out that it would cost \$2,500 to provide all of the information I requested concerning Guam for both 1972 and 1973. The cost is this large because the information is available only through the Justice Department's main computer, and would require a special run. The cost for only one year would be half as much - \$1,250. The cost for any given table would be 1/8 of the cost for any year. In other words, for \$150, we could obtain a single table for a single year.

I told Mr. Prosek that I would review our request to determine if there was any one table which would be particularly useful. Another alternative is to request the information from the United States, and let them pick up the cost of the calculations.
