SAIPAN, JAN. 2 (MNS)---BUSINESSES, EMPLOYERS, AND INDIVIDUALS ARE REMINDED THAT THE QUARTERLY TAX RETURNS FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 1974 THRU DECEMBER 31, 1974 ARE DUE NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 31, 1975.

ALSO, EMPLOYERS WHO WITHHELD THE THREE PERCENT TRUST TERRITORY INCOME TAX FROM THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF THEIR EMPLOYEES DURING THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 1974 THRU DECEMBER 31, 1974 JUST FILE THE 1974 TRUST TERRITORY WAGE AND TAX STATEMENTS ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 31, 1975.

AN EMPLOYER WHO FILES THESE STATEMENTS AFTER JANUARY 31, 1975, WILL BE ASSESSED A FIVE DOLLAR PENALTY FOR EACH STATEMENT FILED. FORMS FOR FILING AND INFORMATION REGARDING THE FILING OF THESE FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE DISTRICT REVENUE OFFICE.

(YAPESE STUDENT KILLED)

SAIPAN, JAN. 2 (MNS)---THE BODY OF A YAPESE STUDENT WHO DIED IN HILO, HAWAII, WAS RETURNED TO YAP SATURDAY (DEC. 28) FOR BURIAL.

JOHN UOLAI, 23, OF WOLEAI, YAP, DIED IN A FALL FROM A STEEP CLIFF NORTH OF KALAPANA WHILE ON AN OPIHI-PICKING EXPEDITION WITH A FELLOW STUDENT ON DECEMBER 23.

UOLAI WAS A SECOND YEAR STUDENT IN HILO COLLEGE'S FEDERALLY FUNDED BIOCHEMICAL STUDIES FOR MINORITY STUDENTS. HE WAS DECLARED DEAD ON ARRIVAL AT HILO HOSPITAL AFTER HIS BODY WAS LIFTED FROM THE ROCKS BELOW THE 35-FOOT CLIFF BY THE BIG ISLAND'S RESCUE HELICOPTER, ACCORDING TO A REPORT IN THE HONOLULU ADVERTISER.
