

(JAPANESE FILM IN MICRONESIA) 1975

SAIPAN, JAN. 7 (MNS)---A JAPANESE TELEVISION COMPANY HAS BEEN GRANTED PERMISSION BY THE TRUST TERRITORY GOVERNMENT TO DO A TELEVISION DOCUMENTARY DEPICTING LIFE STYLES IN MICRONESIA.

THE TOHOKU BROADCASTING COMPANY (TBC) IS SENDING A FOUR-MAN CREW WHICH WILL BEGIN FILMING THIS WEEK AND IS EXPECTED TO COMPLETE ITS WORK IN EARLY FEBRUARY.

THE GROUP WILL FILM SCENES & ACTIVITIES IN YAP, PONAPE, TRUK, AND SAIPAN.

IN YAP DISTRICT, TBC WILL FILM THE SOCIAL RANKING SYSTEM, THE COEXISTENCE OF TRADITIONAL AND CONTEMPORARY CULTURES, AND STONE MONEY.

IN PONAPE DISTRICT, PONAPE LIFE STYLES, AND THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE OF MICRONESIA WILL BE FEATURED.

IN TRUK, THE CREW WILL VISIT MOEN, THE DISTRICT CENTER AND TOL ISLAND TO INTERVIEW THE DESCENDANTS OF MOSEN MORI FAMILY PRESENTLY ACTIVE AS LEADERS IN TRUK, AND WILL DO AN INTERVIEW WITH CHIEF MAGISTRATE SUSUMU AIZAWA OF TOL, A FORMER PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL PITCHER OF MAINICHI ORIOLS TEAM AND WILL TOUR TRUK LAGOON.

ON SAIPAN, THE TELEVISION CREW WILL OBSERVE THE CURRENT SITUATION OF JAPANESE VISITORS TO SAIPAN; THE REMAINS OF BATTERIES AND FORTIFICATIONS USED BY THE JAPANESE FORCES DURING THE WAR. THEY WILL ALSO HAVE AN INTERVIEW WITH MAYOR VICENTE D. SABLAN OF SAIPAN.
