LAND LAW EXAMINER AT THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, DIVISION OF LANDS AND SURVEYS, EMMET M. RICE, HAS BEEN NAMED ACTING DIRECTOR OF TERRITORIAL AFFAIRS (DOTA), BY THE INTERIOR DEPARTMENT, ACCORDING TO A GANNET NEWS SERVICE STORY PUBLISHED ON FRIDAY'S (JAN. 10) EDITION OF GUAM'S PACIFIC DAILY NEWS. RICE, 43, WHO WORKED IN THE TRUST TERRITORY FOR TWO YEARS, FILLS THE VACANCY LEFT 10 DAYS AGO BY THE DEPARTURE OF STANLEY S. CARPENTER, WHO HAS RETURNED TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

ACCORDING TO THE GANNET STORY, FRED RADEWAGERN, CARPENTER'S ASSISTANT, MADE IT KNOWN WEDNESDAY IN WASHINGTON THAT HE IS ALSO LEAVING ON FEBRUARY 15, BUT HAS NO DEFINITE PLANS.

AFTER HIS TOUR ON SAIPAN, RICE WENT TO WASHINGTON AND SERVED AS AN INTERIOR DEPARTMENT REPRESENTATIVE ON THE MICRONESIAN STATUS NEGOTIATING TEAM UNDER FRANKLIN HAYDN WILLIAMS. IN OCTOBER, HE BECAME CARPENTER'S "ASSISTANT FOR MICRONESIAN AFFAIRS." RICE SAID HE EXPECTS TO CONTINUE WORKING IN THE MICRONESIAN FIELD AND CONSIDERS IT HIS SECOND CAREER.

HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON SAID OF RICE'S APPOINTMENT: "WE HAVE ENJOYED WORKING WITH EMMET RICE IN THE PAST AND WE WILL LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH HIM IN THE FUTURE. HIS PAST EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE OF MICRONESIAN AFFAIRS WILL BE OF GREAT VALUE AND WE KNOW HE WILL CONTINUE TO DO AN OUTSTANDING JOB."

OTHER ORGANIZING WORK WILL INCLUDE APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS TO STANDING AND JOINT COMMITTEES OF THE CONGRESS.

THE ANNUAL STATE OF THE TERRITORY MESSAGE IS EXPECTED TO BE DELIVERED BY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON AS SOON AS BOTH HOUSES ARE DULY ORGANIZED AND READY TO CONDUCT BUSINESS.
