MOTION TO DISMISS

Come now the Defendants Marianas Political Status Commission and Mariana Islands District Legislature and move to dismiss Plaintiff's request for a permanent injunction on the following grounds:

- 1. The Plaintiff has failed to state a valid cause of action in that the Court is requested to prevent the people of the Mariana Islands District and Defendants from exercising their legally protected rights of self-determination, political expression and assembly, and in the alternative
- 2. The Plaintiff requests the Court to resolve a political issue which is beyond the jurisdiction of the Court, and in the alternative
- 3. The Plaintiff requests the Court to intervene in the functions of the legislative branch and the orderly election processes of the Marianas District which is beyond the scope of authority of the Court, and in the alternative
- 4. The Plaintiff asks the Court to entertain a suit against the Defendants who are quasi-sovereign entities making them immune from suit because Defendants have Anever consented to said suit, and in the alternative
- 5. The Plaintiff is estopped from requesting injunctive relief under the doctrine of laches by his failure to bring a timely cause of action, and in the alternative

6. The Plaintiff has no standing to sue as no irreparable injury has been shown to result from the prospective actions of the Defendants.

NOW THEREFORE the Defendants Marianas Political Status Commission and the Mariana Islands District Legislature respectfully pray this honorable Court:

- Dismiss Plaintiff's cause of action; and
- 2. Award Defendants all costs of defense including reasonable attorneys fees; and
 - 3. Such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
