CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA ACTIONS AGAINST MARIANAS SEPARATE TALKS

1. Senate Joint Resolution 99 of August 24, 1970 "Declaring that the U.S. and the United Nations should take no action on any matter relating to the future political status of Micronesia without first obtaining the consent and approval of the Congress of Micronesia."
2. House Joint Resolution 90 of August 20, 1970 "Declaring that the Offer of Commonwealth Status for Micronesia in the form that it was presented to the Congress of Micronesia through its political status delegation is not acceptable to the Congress of Micronesia."
3. Senate Joint Resolution <sup>117</sup>~~32~~ of September 2, 1972. "Authorizing and directing the Joint Committee on Future Status to conduct negotiations with the United States regarding the establishment of Micronesia as an independent nation".
4. Senate Joint Resolution 38 of February 26, 1973. "Declaring that the Joint Committee on Future Status is the sole authority in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands which is legally authorized and empowered to conduct negotiation with regard to the future status of the Trust Territory including all parts thereof."
5. Senate Joint Resolution 131 of August 8, 1974. "Declaring in strongest possible terms, the opposition of the Congress of Micronesia to and condemnation of the separate administration of any part of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands prior to the holding throughout all parts of the Trust Territory of a plebiscite on the future status of Micronesia..."
