

(ZEDER NAMED DOTD)

WASHINGTON, APRIL 18 (MNS)---RED MONROE ZEDER, A DALLAS, TEXAS, MANUFACTURER AND CIVIC LEADER, HAS BEEN DESIGNATED NEW DIRECTOR OF THE INTERIOR DEPARTMENT'S OFFICE OF TERRITORIES, ACCORDING TO FRIDAY'S (APRIL 18) ISSUE OF PACIFIC DATELINE, GUAM'S AFTERNOON NEWSPAPER.

CONGRESSIONAL SOURCES ACKNOWLEDGED THAT THE DEPARTMENT HAS INFORMED THEM THAT ZEDER, 54, CHAIRMAN OF HYDROMETALS INC., SINCE 1950, HAD BEEN SELECTED BY INTERIOR SECRETARY ROGERS C.B. MORTON TO FILL THE VACANCY LEFT BY STANLEY S. CARPENTER, WHO HAD BEEN ON LOAN TO INTERIOR FROM THE STATE DEPARTMENT.

ZEDER WOULD BE TAKING OVER THE OFFICE THAT HAS CHARGE OF INTERIOR'S ROLE IN SUCH PLACES AS GUAM, AMERICAN SAMOA, THE VIRGIN ISLANDS, PUERTO RICO AND THE TRUST TERRITORY. HE IS FROM THE FAMILY THAT DEVELOPED THE CHRYSLER AUTOMOBILE AND HE GREW UP IN THE DETROIT AREA.

ZEDER STUDIED ENGINEERING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN UNTIL 1941, THEN ENTERED THE U.S. ARMY AIR CORPS. HE LEFT THE SERVICES AS A MAJOR AND FINISHED HIS SCHOOLING AT UCLA IN 1947. HIS FIELDS WERE ENGINEERING AND POLITICAL SCIENCE, BUT HE GOT INTO THE ADVERTISING BUSINESS WITH HIS OWN FIRM, ZEDER-TALBOT, IN LOS ANGELES AND DETROIT. ZEDER THEN BECAME A VICE-PRESIDENT OF MCCANN-ARICKSON, A NEW YORK CITY ADVERTISING AGENCY, WHERE HE WORKED UNTIL 1956 BEFORE JOINING THE KUDNER ADVERTISING AGENCY FOR A YEAR.

IN 1957, ZEDER BRANCHED INTO ELECTRONIC MANUFACTURING AND INVESTMENTS WITH THE FOUNDING OF CHRYSLER-ZEDER INC., OF WHICH HE BECAME PRESIDENT. TWO YEARS LATER HE BECAME PRESIDENT AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF HYDROMETALS INC. OF NEW YORK AND DALLAS. A FIRM INVOLVED IN A VARIETY OF ENTERPRISES INCLUDING PLUMBING SUPPLIES AND ELECTRONICS MANUFACTURING.

ALTHOUGH ZEDER HAS NO PARTICULAR EXPERTISE IN TERRITORIAL MATTERS, INTERIOR SOURCES SAID HE WAS HIGHLY REGARDED AS A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESS EXECUTIVE AND CIVIC LEADER.

THE APPOINTMENT DOES NOT REQUIRE SENATE CONFIRMATION, BUT ZEDER HAS ALREADY BEGUN MAKING COURTESY CALLS TO MEMBERS OF CONGRESS INVOLVED IN INTERIOR MATTERS.

(TENCPIO REQUEST UNITY FUNDS)

Saipan, April 18 (MNS)---MARIANAS SENATOR PEDRO A. TENCPIO HAS SUBMITTED A REQUEST TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA LEADERSHIP FOR \$10,000 FOR POLITICAL EDUCATION IN THE MARIANAS DISTRICT.

IN HIS LETTER TO SENATE PRESIDENT JOSINO MAKAYADA AND HOUSE SPEAKER BETHUEL HENRY, TENCPIO SUBMITTED HIS "PROGRAM PROPOSAL AND COST ESTIMATE," WHICH WILL INCLUDE THE USE OF TELEVISION TIME TO EXPLAIN THE COVENANT, COMPACT OF FREE ASSOCIATION AND INDEPENDENCE; USE OF NEWSPAPER MEDIA FOR PUBLICATION OF COMPARATIVE INFORMATION ON THE THREE ALTERNATIVES; TRAVEL TO KOTA AND TINIAN; PUBLICATION OF 5,000 COPIES OF THE COVENANT. OTHER INCIDENTAL EXPENSES WILL BE PAID BY VOLUNTEERS, CONSISTING OF CAPOLINIANS AND CHANCEROS AS WELL AS OTHER INTERESTED IT CITIZENS.

TENCPIO STATED THAT HE WILL BE PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COORDINATION OF THE PROGRAM AS WELL AS THE ACCOUNTING OF PUBLIC FUNDS FROM THE CONGRESS.

THE MARIANAS SENATOR STATED IN ANOTHER LETTER THAT IF HIS REQUEST IS NOT APPROVED, HE URGED THE MEMBERS OF CONGRESS TO "STAY OUT OF OUR LOCAL AFFAIRS."

(TRUST TERRITORY GAINS PEACESAT CONSORTIUM MEMBERSHIP)

SAIPAN, APR. 18 (MMS)---THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS HAS BEEN ACCEPTED INTO MEMBERSHIP IN THE INTERNATIONAL PEACESAT CONSORTIUM, AN ORGANIZATION ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE A COORDINATING MECHANISM TO FACILITATE THE FUNDING OF EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER NONPROFIT PROJECTS AND BRING MAJOR RESEARCH AND ADVANCED EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES AND PROGRAMS TO THE PACIFIC REGION.

THE TRUST TERRITORY WAS VOTED INTO MEMBERSHIP AT A MEETING OF THE CONSORTIUM COUNCIL HELD THURSDAY, (APRIL 17), VIA SATELLITE, ACCORDING TO GEORGE T. CALLISON MANAGER OF THE TT'S GROUND TERMINAL ON SAIPAN. ALSO VOTED INTO MEMBERSHIP WERE THE SOUTH PACIFIC COMMISSION AND THE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY IN PAPUA-NEW GUINEA.

IN ADDITION TO PROVIDING A COORDINATING FUNDING MECHANISM, THE CONSORTIUM HAS TWO OTHER MAJOR GOALS: TO WORK COOPERATIVELY IN IMPROVING TWO-WAY COMMUNICATIONS WITHIN THE PACIFIC BASIN AND THEREBY REDUCE THE GEOGRAPHIC ISOLATION AND FRAGMENTATION OF THE BILINGUAL AND MULTILINGUAL POPULATIONS OF THE PACIFIC REGIONS; AND INCREASED EDUCATIONAL, HEALTH, AND ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES FOR PEOPLE IN THE PACIFIC AREAS BY PERMITTING THE SHARING OF RESOURCES AND IDEAS THROUGH TWO-WAY CONSULTATIONS.

THE RESEARCH CORPORATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII - A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION- HAS BEEN RETAINED AS THE CONSORTIUM'S FISCAL AND COORDINATING AGENT.

AT THE APRIL 17 ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF THE CONSORTIUM COUNCIL, MARTIN KIMBALL, CHAIRMAN OF THE WELLINGTON POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE COUNCIL, IN NEW ZEALAND, WAS CHOSEN AS CHAIRMAN OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS; DR. JOHN BYSTROM, DIRECTOR OF PEACESAT, UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, WAS ELECTED EXECUTIVE SECRETARY. THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR BOTH KIMBALL AND BYSTROM WILL EXTEND UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 1975.

EDWARD E. JOHNSTON, TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER SIGNED THE CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT FOR THE TRUST TERRITORY ON FEBRUARY 3. IN AN ACCOMPANYING LETTER TO DR. BYSTROM HE SAID, "THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS HAS BENEFITED SIGNIFICANTLY FROM ITS TWENTY MONTHS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE PEACESAT PROJECT AND WE LOOK FORWARD WITH GREAT ANTICIPATION TO EXPANDED OPPORTUNITIES IN THE FUTURE IN WHAT YOU DESCRIBE AS A "UNIQUE EXPERIMENT IN SATELLITE COMMUNICATION." IN THE SAME LETTER, THE HIGH COMMISSIONER NAMED THREE PERSONS TO SERVE AS TRUST TERRITORY REPRESENTATIVES IN ALL CONSORTIUM FUNCTIONS AND MEETINGS: JUAN A. SABLAN, EXECUTIVE OFFICER; DR. MASAO KUNANGAI, DIRECTOR OF HEALTH SERVICES; AND GEORGE CALLISON, PEACESAT TERMINAL MANAGER, WITH ELIAS H. THOMAS, CHIEF OF BROADCAST DIVISION, TO SERVE AS HIS ALTERNATE.

THROUGH ITS SAIPAN TERMINAL, THE TRUST TERRITORY HAS BEEN PARTICIPATING IN PEACESAT EXCHANGES FOR THE PAST TWO YEARS.

(ADA EXTENDS SLOT MACHINES MORATORIUM)

SAIPAN, APR. 18 (MMS)---IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON IN THE MARIANAS "TO POSSESS OR OWN ANY SLOT MACHINE BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 1976," MARIANAS DISTRICT ADMINISTRATOR, FRANCISCO C. ADA SAID IN SIGNING THE "NOTICE" EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ON THE IMPORTATION OF SLOT MACHINES INTO THE MARIANAS.

DISTAD ADA'S NOTICE SAID THAT EVERY PERSON WHO OWNS OR POSSESSES ANY SLOT MACHINE SHALL WITHIN TEN DAYS FOLLOWING ACQUISITION OF SUCH OWNERSHIP OR POSSESSION REPORT TO THE MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY, ON FORMS TO BE PROVIDED BY THE MAYOR, INFORMATION WHICH SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: "(A) THE

SERIAL NUMBER OF THE MACHINE; AND THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE OWNER OR POSSESSOR OF THE MACHINE."

DISTAD ADA POINTED OUT THAT THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON GAMBLING, MADE UP OF CROSS-SECTIONAL REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMUNITY, IN A LETTER DATED DECEMBER 20, 1974, RECOMMENDED TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER THAT A MORATORIUM ON FURTHER IMPORTATION OF SLOT MACHINES BE EFFECTUATED AND THAT A MORATORIUM BE EFFECTED IMMEDIATELY.

DISTAD ADA FURTHER ADDED THAT THE COMMITTEE IN ITS FINAL REPORT TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER, HAS RECOMMENDED THAT COMMERCIAL GAMBLING INCLUDING SLOT MACHINES BE PROHIBITED IN THE TRUST TERRITORY INCLUDING SAIPAN.

ACCORDING TO ADA, A CONSIDERABLE NUMBER OF PEOPLE INCLUDING COMMUNITY LEADERS HAVE EXPRESSED THEIR CONCERN OVER THE ADVERSE EFFECTS OF SLOT MACHINES ON THE WELFARE OF THE RESIDENTS OF SAIPAN.

THE MORATORIUM ON IMPORTATION OF SLOT MACHINES INTO THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAIPAN SHALL TAKE EFFECT ON APRIL 18, 1975, FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY DAYS, ACCORDING TO DISTAD ADA.
