SAIPAN, APR. 21 (MNS) ===SIX BILLS PASSED BY THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA IN ITS REGENT REGULTR SEASION ON SAIPAN HAVE BEEN SIGNED INTO LAW BY DEPUTY HIGH COMPLISIONER PETER T. COLEMAN. THE BILLS WERE SIGNED FRIDAY, (APIRL 18). THREE OTHERS WERE VETOED, (SEE SEPARATE STORY).

THE SIGNED BILLS ARE:

TO APPROPRIATE \$132,621 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE Congress and \$45,207 From the TT social security retirement fund

FOR THE OPERATION OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY SUBJECT WHICH BEGINS APRIL 1, 1975 TO MARCH 31, 1975 AND TO MAKE PROVISIONS FOR FUTURE FUNDING AND OPERATIONS OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM, (HB 6-4), PUBLIC LAW 6-49;

TO CONVERT THE SOUIAL SECURITY SYSTEM'S OPERATING BUDGET To the congress of micronesia fiscal year, (HB 6-118), pl 6=50;

SAIPAN, APR. 21 (MNS)---DEPUTY HIGH COMMISSIONER PETER T. COLEMAN VETOED SUNDAY, (APRIL 20), A BILL TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW BASE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR TRUST TERRITORY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES. IN DUING SO, THE DEPUTY HIGH COMMISSIONER LISTED THREE "PARAMOUNT REASONS" FOR DISAPPROVING THE BILL, FIRST IS THE

"ESCALATION OF IMPLEMENTATION COSTST UNDER A SECTION OF THE BILL, BOTH IN THE AMOUNT OF INCREASE PROPOSED FOR EACH PAY LEVEL, AND FURTHER, "THE UNSUPPORTED EXPANSION OF SUCH INCREASE" INCLUDING PAY LEVELS ABOVE PL-15, HE STATED IN A LETTER TO SENATE PRESIDENT TOSIWO NAKAYAMA.

OTHER PROVISIONS IN THE BILL"COULD ONLY ADVERSELY AFFECT EMPLOYEE MORALE AND CRIPPLE EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT, " AND GERTAIN SECTIONS "SEEK TO LIMIT THE POWER OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS" OF TRAMPT EXECUTIVE POSITIONS.

COLEMAN ALSO NOTED THAT THE CONGRESS FARMER'S THE J. LAD "TEMPORARY RELIEF" TO THE LOCAL MARE SET OF JOY

ANOTHER CONCERN WHICH COLEMAN POINTED OUT YO NAKAYAMA IS THE ESTIMATED \$1.5 MILLION COST FOR UNBUDGETED WITHIN-GRADE INCREASES FOR FY 1976 FOR MICRONESIAN EMPLOYEES AND 5.6 MILLION

FOR RECLASSIFICATION OF TEACHERS AND RELATED POSITIONS. ACCORDING TO TO THE DEPUTY HIGH COMMISSIONER, THE TOTAL COSTS IN BASE PAYROLL WOULD RANGE FROM \$2.5 TO \$3.7 MILLION.

COLEMAN ALSO REMINDED NAKAYAMA OF THE JOINT TASK FORCE ON SALARIES AND THE RISING COST-OF-LIVING IN THE TT WHICH INCLUDED PEPRESENTATIVES OF THE CONGRESS THAT WORKED TO FORMULATE AND RECOMMEND THE MINIMUM WAGE FOR THE TT.

".... HAD THE CONGRESS NOT ADDED CERTAIN SECTIONS, OVER WHAT HAD BEEN CONSIDERED BY THE JOINT TASK FORCE.... WE PROBABLY WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN COMPELLED TO EFFECT THIS DISAPPROVAL ACTION," COLEMAN STATED IN HIS LETTER.

THE OTHER THREE MEASURES VETOED BY COLEMAN WERE A BILL TO CREATE A JOINT COMMITTEE ON MICRONESIAN CLAIMS (HB 6-144); A MEASURE TO DELINEATE THE WORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN DISTRICT FISHING AUTHORITIES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE TT GUVERNMENT, (HB 6=161); AND A BILL TO ALLOW STUDENTS ON TT SCHOLARSHIPS TO RECEIVE ROOM AND BOARD AT THE DISTRICT CENTERS WHILE ON TRAVEL STATUS TO AND FROM THE INSTITUTIONS ACCEPTING THEM, (HB 6-46).

SAIPAN, APR. 21 (MNS)--- A NEW RADIO TELETYPEWRITER CIRCUIT CONNECTS THE TRUST TERRITURY MAJOR RELAY/CONTROL STATION IN SAIPAN WITH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION'S INTERNATIONAL AERONAUTICAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SWITCHING CENTER (IATSC), IN HONOLULU. TRUST TERRITORY CHIEF OF COMMUNICATIONS VICTORINO T. BORJA ANNOUNCED COMMISSIONING OF THE 100-WORDS-FER MINUTE SERVICE CHANNEL ON MONDAY. (APRIL 21).

IN A MESSAGE TO HOUSE SPEAKER BETHWEL HENRY REGARDING A BILL TO DELINEATE THE HORKING RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE DISTRICT FISHING AUTHORITIES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND DEVELOPMENT, COLEMAN REASONED THAT IT IS "IMPROPER" TO IDENTIFY A FISHING AUTHORITY AS A "POLICY MAKING BODY" AS RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF FISHERY AND MARINE RESOURCES.

HIGH COMMISSIONER. THE MASTER PLAN, WHICH WAS COMMISSIONED BY THE PALAU FEDERATION OF FISHING ASSOCIATIONS AND THE PALAU FISHING AUTHORITY AT THE COST OF \$3,000 WAS PREPARED BY GLOBAL ASSOCIATES OF GUAM LAST JANUARY. THE PLAN WAS PRESENTED TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA AND THE HIGH COMMISSIONER IN FEBRUARY.

THE PLAN SUPPORTS THE CONTENTION OF THE PALAU FISHING AUTHORITY THAT A SUCCESSFUL DEVELOPMENT OF FISHERIES IN PALAU DEPENDS ON ESTABLISHING A CENTRAL REEFER AND STORAGE FACILITIES IN KOROR AND SATELLITE FACILITIES IN ANGAUR AND PELELIU IN SOUTHER PALAU AND OLLEX IN NORTHERN PALAU, THELE 38 ANOTHER SATELLITE FACILITY PRESENTLY BEING ESTABLISHED IN NGERENLENGUI IN WESTERN PALAU, THE SATELLITE FACILITYING APA BEING PLANNED FOR THE AREAS OF PALAU WHERE REEF FIGH A CAL ABOUNDS.

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
