I very much appreciated talking with you the other day and I am deeply grateful for your concern and for the interest of Secretary Morton. It is most reassuring to receive such support.

We have once again examined the facilities at the Civic Center. Were we to occupy any space there, we would have to relocate considerable District staff personnel presently occupying such facilities. While this is not an impossible task, it is, in our opinion, unnecessary.

On Wednesday afternoon, after speaking with you, we held our first meeting in our new office (Hamilton's) and this facility proved to be quite adequate and totally acceptable. If, however, this proves to be impossible, we will immediately contact you regarding Mr. Cruz' availability.
