WHEREAS, the signing of this historic document will bring to the people 5. in the Mariana Islands District a time measure of self-determination and an 6. opportunity to exercise their god given right, to liberty, and freedom; and 7. WHEREAS, more than two years were spent by representatives of the United 8. States and the Mariana Islands District discussing the various options that 9. are open to the people of the Mariana Islands District; the needs of the United 10. States of America; and other partinent subject affecting the Marianas and the 11. 12. United States: and

WHEREAS, we the elected representatives of the Municipality of Saipan. 13. in the exercise of our authority and responsibility to the people do hereby 14. 15. officially go on record of supporting and endorsing the Covenant to establish the Commonwealth Covernment of the Marianas Island District, now, therefore, 16.
