INTRODUCED BY THE COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE. RESOLUTION NO. 02-1975.

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY ADVISING ALL THE PEOPLE OF THE WHOLE WORLD THAT THE PEOPLE OF TINIAN WANTS AND SUPPORTS U. S. COMMONWEALTH AND THAT THE HONORABLES JOSE R. CRUZ AND BERNARD V. HOFSCHEIDER ARE THE ONLY AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL SPOKESMAN AND REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PEOPLE OF TINIAN ON ALL POLITICAL STATUS MATTERS.

WHEREAS, all the people of the world are respectfully reminded, cautioned, and are hereby advised that ONLY the Honorable Jose R. CRUZ, and the Honorable Bernard V. HOSCHNEIDER, are the official representative and spokesman for the people of Tinian on all Tinian political status issues; and


WHEREAS, all the Nations of the world are hereby respectfully informed that the people of Tinian supports and wants United States Commonwealth Status in political Union with the United States of America; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TINIAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, that all Nations of the World are hereby respectfully informed that the people of Tinian strongly supports and wants United States Commonwealth Status in Political Union with the United States of America; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all the people of the world are respectfully reminded, cautioned, and are hereby advised, that ONLY the Honorable Jose R. CRUZ and the Honorable Bernard V. HOFSCHEIDER are the official representative and spokesman of the people of Tinian on all Tinian Political Status matters; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the United Nations and all other Nations of the World are respectfully reminded, advised, and cautioned that no person or persons, including the Tinian Mayor Felipe C. MENDIOLA, are authorized by the people of Tinian to speak, act, or represent Tinian and its people on any political status matters, except for the Honorable Jose R. CRUZ and the Honorable Bernard V. HOFSCHEIDER, who are member of the Marianas Political Status Commission.
