IN A MAY 16 LETTER TO MARIANAS SENATOR PEDRO A. TENORIO, BURTON EXPRESSED "STRONG DETERMINATION THAT THE PLEBISCITE ON THE COVENANT BE A FREE AND OPEN EXPRESSION OF THE WILL OF THE MARIANAS PEOPLE, UNINTERFERRED WITH AND UNINFLUENCED BY OUTSIDE FORCES..."

BURTON, WHO IS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE SUBCOMMITTEE ON TERRITORIAL AND INSULAR AFFAIRS, STATED THAT HE WILL "SUPPORT AND RESPECT." THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS AS EXPRESSED BY THE PLEBISCITE. "THIS PLEDGE INCLUDES, OF COURSE, SUPPORT OF THE COVENANT IF IT IS APPROVED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANASNE BURTON WROTE.

WITH RESPECT TO RESTRICTING AMERICAN ABILITY TO PURCHASE LAND IN THE NORTHERN MARIANAS, BURTON SAID THIS PROVISION "WILL NOT BE CHANGED BY THE CONGRESS."

HE FURTHER YOLD SENATOR TENORIO THAT THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH, NOT THE U.S. CONGRESS THAT HAS THE AUTHORITY TO NEGOTIATE AGREEMENTS SUCH AS THE COVENANT. "ANY SUGGESTION THAT I OR ANY MEMBER OF THE CONGRESS WOULD NEGOTIATE FOR THE AMERICAN SIDE IN THE EVENT THE COVENANT IS APPROVED, IS CONTRARY TO FACT," HE POINTED OUT.

THE CALIFORNIA CONGRESSMAN ASSURED TENORIO THAT THE CONGRESS "WILL NOT ALTER THE COVENANT," BUT THAT CONGRESSIONAL ACTION WILL BE A TOTAL ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF THE COVENANT AS NEGOTIATED BY THE U.S. AND MARIANAS NEGOTIATORS. (PALACIOS STATEMENT ON COVENANT)

SAIPAN, MAY 22 (MNS)---THE MARIANAS TERRITORIAL PARTY
IS "OFFICIALLY ENDORSING" THE NORTHERN MARIANAS COMMONWEALTH
COVENANT, ACCORDING TO DR. FRANCISCO PALACIGS, CHAIRMAN OF
THE PARTY:

IN A STATEMENT ISSUED WEDNESDAY, (MAY 21), PALACIOS STATED THAT THE PARTY "BY CONSENSUS," HAS REACHED AN AGREEMENT TO ENDORSE THA COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANAS IN POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES.

THE TERRITORIAL PARTY PRESIDENT SAIDTHAT THE AGREEMENT TO ENDORSE THE COVNANT WAS REACHED AFTER THE LEADERSHIP EVALUATED VARIOUS OPINIONS OF THE PARTY MEMBERS. HE SAID. THAT COMMONWEALTH STATUS IS "THE BEST POLITICAL STATUS" FOR THE MARIANAS AMONG THE ALTERNATIVES DE TREE ASSOCIATION INDENDENDENCE OF STATUS DUO.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR WERE TO FURTHER THE DEVELOPMENT OF MARKETS FOR COCONUT PRODUCTS, GAIN A BETTER APPRECIATION OF THE IMPORTANCE OF MODERN MARKETING ANS SALES PROMOTION TECHNIOUSES AND THEREBY INCREASE THE AWARENESS IN THE COCONUT PRODUCING COUNTRIES OF THE VALIDITY OF CONCERTED AND JOINT! STRATEGIES, AND ACTION THROUGH APPROPRIATE PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGNS IN THE FACE OF COMPETITION FROM SUBSTITUES.
