WE THE NINETYTHREE DELEGATES TO THE CONFERENCE FOR A NUCLEAR FREE PACIFIC FROM TWENTYTWO COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES AUSTRALIA CANADA COLOMBIA COOK ISLANDS ENGLAND FIJI FRANCE GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS GUAN HAWAII JAPAN MICRONESIA NEW CAEDONIA NEW HEBRIDES NEW ZEALAND PAPUA NEW GUINEA PHILIPPINES SOLOMON ISLANDS SWEDEN TONGA USA WESTERN SAMOA ARE CONCERNED ABOUT THE PROCESS OF DECOLONISATION OF MICRONESIA AND WISH TO PETITION YOU WITH RESPECT TO FIRST ITS STATUS AS A NONSELF GOVERNING TERRITORY SECOND THE FORTHCOMING PLEBISCITE ON COMMONWEALTH STATUS FOR THE MARIANAS WHICH UNDERMINES THE UNITY OF THE MICRONESIAN PEOPLE AND THE IMPLICATIONS OF WHICH UNDERMINES THE UNITY OF THE MICRONESIAN PEOPLE AND THE IMPLICATIONS OF WHICH WERE INSUFFICIENTLY COMMUNICATED TO THE INDIGENES THIRD ITS USE FOR NUCLEAR AND MISSILE TESTING AND FOR MILITARY BASES FOURTH ECONOMIC DOMINATION OF THE TERRITORY BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FIFTH THE LACK OF PEOPLE MEDICAL CARE AND ADEQUATE COMPENSATION FOR THE PEOPLE OF UTIRIK AND RONGELAP IN THE MARSHALL GROUP WHO CONTINUE TO SUFFER FROM THE EFFECTS OF RADIOACTIVE FALLOUT FROM UNITED STATES H-BOMB TESTS STOP WE ARE CERTAIN THAT ALL THESE ISSUES ARE IMPORTANT IN THE DISCUSSION OF SELF DETERMINATION FOR MICRONESIA AND URGE YOUR COMMITTEE TO MEET THE DELEGATION FROM THE CONFERENCE
