1. SOV REP ON TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL, NEKLESSA, TOLD AMB WHITE MAY 29 THAT SOVS DEFINITELY WOULD NOT PARTICIPATE IN VISITING MISSION TO OBSERVE MARIANAS PLEBISCITE. SAID THAT WE MUST UNDERSTAND LONG-STANDING SOV POSITION IN OPPOSITION TO SEPARATION OF MARIANAS, WHICH HE WOULD REITERATE STRONGLY IN GENERAL DEBATE STATEMENT. INDICATED, HOWEVER, THAT HE THOUGHT SOVS MIGHT WELL PARTICIPATE IN NEXT REGULAR VISITING MISSION TO TRUST TERRITORY NEXT SPRING.

2. INTERESTINGLY, DURING EXTENSIVE QUESTIONING OF ADMINISTERING POWER DURING COUNCIL SESSION YESTERDAY, NEKLESSA ASKED NO QUESTIONS ABOUT MARIANAS. SCALI
