- 503. Inapplicability of certain federal laws;

- STEP 2 Provisions which become effective on a date which will be within six months after both the Covenant and the Constitution of the Northern Marianas have been approved by both the United States and the Northern Mariana Islands:

- STEP 3 Provisions effective upon termination of the Trusteeship Agreement:
 - 101. Creation of the Commonwealth territory in political union with and under the sovereignty of the United States;
 - 104. United States foreign affairs and defense authorities (the United States will continue to have this authority under the Trusteeship Agreement until its termination);

- 301-03. United States citizenship and nationality;
- <u>506</u>. Immigration and naturalization laws of the United States;
- 806. Eminent domain authority of the United States;
- <u>904</u>. Marianas views and participation in certain international affairs.
