RESOLUTION NO. 106-1975

INTRODUCED BY: COMMITTEE OF THE WEDLE

A RESOLUTION RESPECTIVILLY URGING THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO TAKE PROMPT ACTION ON THE JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE COVIENANT TO RETABLISH THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE HORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS IN FOLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

WHEREAS, THE CHARTER OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND THE TRUSTEESHIP

AGREEMENT DETWEEN THE UNITED HATIOUS AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

REQUIRE THAT THE INHADITALITS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY DE PROMOTED TOWARD

SELF-COVERNMENT OR INDEPENDENCE AS MAY DE APPROPRIATE TO THE PARTICULAR

CIRCUMSTANCES; AND

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HAVE LIVED UNDER THE AUTOCRATIC RULES OF FOREIGN FUELES WITHOUT THE RIGHT TO SPEAK OUT ON THE DEPORTANT MATTERS WHICH FACED THEM, SUCH AS THE NATURE OF THEIR COVERNMENT, THE DEVELOPMENT OF THEIR ECONOMY AND

THEIR FUTURE POLITICAL DESTINY; AND

WHEREAS, THE COMING OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE MARIANAS UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE UNITED NATIONS TRUSTRESHIP USHERS IN A NEW ERA FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS AND INTRODUCES THE SPERIT AND PRINCIPLES OF DEMOCRACY, THE BILL OF REGHTS AND THE IDEALS WHICH HAVE SUSTAINED THE UNITED STATES FOR ALLEDST 260 YEARS; AND

WHEREAS, THE UNITED STATES ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST TERRITORY OF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS HAS EROUGHT TO THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANAS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATION, HEALTH CARE AND POLITICAL MATURITY AND HAS TAUGHT THE REOPLE HOW TO LIVE AS FREE MEN AND WOMEN; AND

WHEREAS, THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS HAVE OVER THE PAST TWENTY
YEARS OR MORE EXPRESSED THEIR FERVENT DESIRE AND ASPIRATION TO JOIN THE
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN A CLOSE AND PERMANENT POLITICAL RELATIONSHIP; AND

WHEREAS, THE FUTURE FOLITICAL STATUS DESIRED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIADA ISLANDS DISTRICT IS FAR DIFFERENT FROM THAT WHICH HAS BEEN CHOSEN BY THE PEOPLE OF THE OTHER DISTRICTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY AS EXPRESSED BY THEIR REPRESENTATIVES IN THE CONGRESS OF MICRONISIA; AND

WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN REPEATEDLY RECOCNIZED WITHIN THE MARIANA ISLANDS
DISTRICT, IN THE OTHER DISTRICTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY, AND WITHIN THE
UNITED NATIONS THAT THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT DESIRE A
POLITICAL STATUS WHICH IS FAR DIFFERENT FROM THAT DESIRED BY THE PEOPLE OF
THE OTHER DISTRICTS OF THE TRUST TERRITORY: AND

WHEREAS, IN MAY 1972 THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE

CREATED THE MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION, WHICH CONSISTS OF

REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL OF THE PEOPLE OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS; AND

WHEREAS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DESIRES OF THE PEOPLE, THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT LEGISLATURE INSTRUCTED THE MARIANAS POLITICAL STATUS COMMISSION TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE UNITED STATES CONCERNING THE TERMS OF A CLOSE, PERMANENT AND EXDURING POLITICAL RELATIONSHIP ENTURES THE UNITED STATES AND THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS; AND

WHEREAS, OVER THE PAST THREE YEARS THE PRESIDENT'S PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE AND THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIAMAS CONDUCTED POLITICAL STATUS NEGOTIATIONS WHICH CULMINATED IN THE SIGNING OF A COVENANT TO ESTABLISH THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIAMA ISLANDS IN POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA; AND

WHEREAS, ON JUNE 17, 1975 IN A FREE AND DEMOCRATICALLY HELD
PLEBISCITE, THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIAMAS VOTEO OVERWHELLINGLY 78.8 PERCENT
TO APPROVE THE SAID COVENANT: AND

WHEREAS, APPROVAL OF THE COVENANT BY THE UNITED STATES CONCRESS
WILL FULFILL THE INALIENABLE AND SOVEREIGN RIGHT OF SELF-DETERMINATION
BY THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT AND CONCLUSIVELY FULFILLING
THEIR DESIRE FOR A CLOSE AND PERMANENT POLITICAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE
UNITED STATES; AND

WHEREAS, IN THE COVENANT, SPECIFIC PROVISIONS ARE INCLUDED TO ENABLE
THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT TO FORMULATE AND ADOPT THEIR
OWN CONSTITUTION AND TO UNDERTAKE CERTAIN ESSENTIAL TRANSITIONAL STUDIES
AND PROGRAMS TOWARD SELF-GOVERNMENT WHICH ARE ALL CONTINGENT UPON APPROVAL
OF THE COVENANT BY THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES.

WHEREAS, THE COVENANT HAS BEEN FAVORABLY ACTED UPON BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, UNITED STATES CONGRESS AND THE UNITED STATES SENATE COMMITTEE ON INTERIOR AND INSULAR AFFAIRS; AND

WHEREAS, IN ORDER NOT TO DELAY THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT OF THE MARIAMAS THAT HAS BEEN SOUGHT BY THE PROPLE THEREOF FOR MORE THAN A QUARTER OF A CENTURY, PROMPT ACTION ON THE PASSAGE OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE "COVEMANT TO ESTABLISH THE COMMUNICALITY OF THE MORTHERN MARIAMA ISLANDS IN POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA" WITHOUT DELAY WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF ALL CONCERNED;

NOW, THEMEFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FOURTH MARIANA ISLANDS

DISTRICT LEGISLATURE, SEVENTH REGULAR SESSION, THAT THE UNITED STATES

SENATE IS HEREBY RESPECTFULLY URGED AND REQUIETED TO TAKE PROMPT AND

FAVORABLE ACTION OF THE JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE "COVENANT TO

ESTABLISH THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANAS IN POLITICAL UNION WITH

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA."

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE PRESIDENT CHITIFY TO AND THE LEGISLATIVE SECRETARY ATTEST THE ADOPTION HEREOF AND TRIBEAUTER TRANSMIT A COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE AND CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE SENATE ARMED SERVICES COMMITTEE, THE PRESIDENT AND THE MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE.

INTRODUCED BY: COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY URGING THE UNITED STATES SENATE TO TAKE PROOPT ACTION ON THE JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE COVENANT TO ESTABLISH THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS IN POLITICAL UNION WITH THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

MHEREAS the Charter of the United Nations and the Trusteeship

Agreement between the United Nations and the United States of America

require that the inhabitants of the Trust Territory be promoted toward

self-government or independence as may be appropriate to the particular

circumstances; and

WHEREAS, for the past 400 years the people of the Mariana

Islands have lived under the autocratic rules of foreign powers without the right to speak out on the important matters which faced them, such as the nature of their government, the development of their economy and their future political destiny; and

WHEREAS, the coming of the United States in the Marianas under the auspices of the United Nations Trusteeship ushers in a new era for the people of the Mariana Islands and introduces the spirit and principles of democracy, the Bill of Rights and the ideals which have sustained the United States for almost 200 years; and

WHEREAS, the United States Administration of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands has brought to the people of the Marianas economic development, education, health care and political maturity and has taught the people how to live as free men and women; and
