The Marianas Covenant (H.J.Res. 549, as amended) is now being considered by the Senate Armed Services Committee and the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations. It is scheduled for mark-up by the Armed Services Subcommittee on General Legislation at 2:00 P.M. on December 16. The full Armed Services Committee and the Foreign Relations Committee are expected to act in January. The two committees are currently scheduled to return the legislation to the floor by January 27.
