

(HIGH COMMISSIONER DELIVERS STATE OF THE TERRITORY MESSAGE) SAIPAN, JAN. 14 (MNS) == TRUST TERRITORY HIGH COMMISSIONER EDWARD E. JOHNSTON DELIVERED HIS ANNUAL "STATE OFLITHE TERRITORY MESSAGE" WEDNESDAY MORNING (JAN.14) OUTSIDE THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVE CHAMBER BEFORE A JCINT SESSION OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA ON SAIPAN. IN HIS ADDRESS, THE HIGH COMMISSIONER REVIEWED THE PROGRESS MADE IN MICRONESIA DURING THE PAST YEAR. MR. JOHNSTON SAID THAT 1975 "WILL ALKAYS BE REMEMBERED AS A TREMENDOUSLY IMPORTANT YEAR IN MICRONESIA'S HISTORY." THE FOLLOWING IS THE COMPLETE TEXT OF HIS SPEECH.

"DURING THE YEAR JUST PAST, THE PEOPLE OF THE MARIANA ISLANDS DISTRICT, IN AN ELECTION OBSERVED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE UNITED NATIONS, VOLED OVERWHELMINGLY TO ADOPT A COVENANT IN CLOSE ASSOCIATION WITH THE UNITED STATES, AND THE APPROVAL OF THIS COVENANT IS NOW PENDING BEFORE UNITED STATES.

"ON NOVEMBER 8. IN A CEREMONY -- THE HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE OF WHICH CAN ONLY BE RIVALLED BY THE CREATION OF THIS CONGRESS IN 1965 -- REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL SIX DISTRICTS SIGNED A DRAFT CONSTITUTION FOR THE PROPOSED FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONUSIA. I AM PLEASED TO REPORT THAT THIS ALL-IMPORTANT DOCUMENT HAS ALKEADY BEEN TRANSLATED INTO TEN LANGUAGES AND THAT THE TRANSLATIONS ARE NOW BEING REVIEWED IN THE DISTRICTS FOR FINAL APPROVAL. LARGELY THROUGH THE EFFORTS OF OUR DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS, MR. STRIK YOMA, HIMSELF A DELEGATE TO THE CONVENTION, IT IS ANTICIPATED THAT THE CONSTITUTION WILL ACTUALLY BE REPRUDUCED AND DISTRIBUTED IN ALL TEN LANGUAGES BY THE END OF THIS CURRENT MONTH, OR SHORTLY THEREAFTER. WE SHALL ASK THIS SESSION OF THE CONGRESS FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING TO SUPPORT THIS PROJECT.

WIN THEIR RESCLUTION NO. 38. THE DELEGATES TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL CUNVENTION URGED THIS SESSION OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA TO WORK TOWARD THE EARLY IMPLEMENTATION OF THOSE PORTIONS OF THE CONSTITUTION WHICH ARE NOT IN FUNDAMENTAL CONFLICT WITH THE TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT. THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH STANDS READY TO ASSIST YOU IN THIS PROJECT AND URGES YOU TO CALL UPON US WHEN SUCH ASSISTANCE IS NEEDED.

"ANOTHER EVENT OF GREAT IMPURTANCE TO THE FUTURE OF ALL MICRONESIA, WHICH OCCURRED DURING 1975, WAS THE BEGINNING OF A COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN. CERTAINLY, GREAT CREDIT MUST GO TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA FOR PROVIDING THE FUNDING FOR THIS IMPORTANT EFFORT TO SUPPLEMENT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME. WE ARE FORTUNATE TO HAVE MR. ROBERT TRUSK, WITH EXPERIENCE IN SIMILAR PROGRAMS IN 31 DIFFERENT COUNTRIES, AS THE HEAD OF THE TEAM WHICH WILL PUTTOGETHER OUR COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN.

"IN EARLY DECEMBER, 1975, THE UNITED NATIONS ASIAN DEVELOPMOND INSTITUTE CUNCLADED A VERY SUCCESSFUL SUB-REGIONAL COURSE ON "PROJECT DEVELOPMENT ANDONNING" WHICH GRADUATED STUDENTS NOT ONLY FROM THROUGHOUT THE TRUST TERRITORY BUT, ALSO, FROM FIJI, TONGA, MALAYSPA, WESTERN SAMOA AND THEPCOOK ISLANDS.

"WE HAVE RECENTLY RECEIVED APPROVAL FROM WASHINGTON TO PROCEED WITH ANOTHER UNDP PROJECT -- TO DEVELOP A LONG-NEEDED STATISTICAL ORGANIZATION WITHIN THE TRUST TERRITORY GOVERNMENT. THIS PROJECT, HOPEFULLY, WILL BE STARTED IN THE VERY NEAR FUTURE. AND WE WILL CERTAINLY CONSIDER THE SUGGESTIONS FOR SETTING UP OUR STATISTICAL OFFICE CONTAINED IN A RECENT LETTER FROM CONGRESSMAN SETIK.

"ON JANUARY 7, 1969 -- MORE THAN SEVEN YEARS

AGO -- A LETTER WAS SENT BY THE TRUST TERRITORY

ADMINISTRATION WHICH PRECEDED OURS TO THE THEN OFFICE OF

TERRITORIES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, ASKING

INTERIOR'S OFFICE OF SURVEY AND REVIEW TO REVIEW AND

COMMENT ON PROPUSALS TO PROVIDE A COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL

MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE TRUST TERRITORY. THE LETTER

SAID, "WE MUST MOVE IN THIS DIRECTION IF WE ARE EVER TO

OBTAIN THE NEEDED FINANCIAL AND GLANTITATIVE DATA

REQUIRED FOR DECISION MAKING."

"SHORTLY AFTER MY ARRIVAL IN THE TRUST TERRITORY, I WAS BRIEFED ON THE NECESSITY FOR AN ADEQUATE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND FOR SIX YEARS HAVE BEEN WELL AWAR VHOF THE FACT THAT THIS COULD NOT BE ACCOMPLISHED IN-HOUSE, AND THAT WE WOULD NEED CONSIDERABLE PROFESSIONAL ASSISTANCE FROM OUTSIDE THE TRUST TERRITORY. ON MY DESK

IS A FILE SOME THREE INCHES THICK OF SUBSEQUENT CORRESPONDENCE WITH OFFICIALS IN WASHINGTON CONSTANTLY SEEKING TO HAVE SUCH A SYSTEM DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED. I AM SURE, THEREFORE, THAT THE CUNGRESS OF MICRONESIA IS AS HAPPY AS I AM THAT AT LONG LAST OUR PLEASE HAVE BEEN HEARD AND THE SYSTEM WHICH WE HAVE SOUGH THESE PAST SEVEN YEARS IS NOW BEING IMPLEMENTED. CERTAINLY THIS CAN BE CONSIDERED AS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT EVENTS OF 1975 WITH WIDE--REACHING BENEFITS TO THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA, THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES, THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF BUTH THE PRESENT AND FUTURE GOVERNMENTS OF MICRONESIA. IN OUR EFFORTS, THUS FAR, TO DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT THE SYSTEM, WE ARE GRATEFUL FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR. THE FEDERAL COMPTROLLER FOR GUAM AND THE TRUST TERRITORY AND THE PEACE CORPS, WHICH HAS FURNISHED A NUMBER OF HIGHLY-QUALIFIED VOLUNTEERS FOR THIS PROJECT.

"THE PAST YEAR HAS BEEN ANOTHER OF CONSIDERABLE PROGRESS IN THE PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT OF MICRONESIA'S LONG OVERDUE INFRASTRUCTURE. CONTRARY TO SOME REPORTS WHICH YOU MAY HAVE READ RECENTLY. THE JALUIT HIGH SCHOOL WAS DEDICATED IN OCTOBER UPUN OHE COMPLETION OF PHASE I OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND IS A STRUCTURE OF WHICH THE PEOPLE OF THE MARSHALLS AND ALL OF MICRONESIA CAN WELL BE PROUD. PHASE II WILL BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE NEXT FEW

THE FIRST HALF OF THIS YEAR. WE HAVE RECEIVED AND TESTED THE FIRST OF OUR NEW FLEET OF SEVEN TUNA FISHING BOATS. AND THE OTHER SIX WILL ALL BE DELIVERED WITHIN THE NEXT FEW MONTHS.

"IMPORTANT PROJECTS STARTED IN 1975 INCLUDE THE LONG-REEDED PALAU BRIDGE, THE TRUST TERRITORY MARICULTURE CENTER AND HOSPITALS IN THE PONAPE AND YAP DISTRICTS.

"BUT MORE IMPORTANT TO ALL OF US IS THAT. IN ADDITION TO BUILDING PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS, WE HAVE CONTINUED TO BUILD PEOPLE: HE HAVE CONTINUED, AS HE HAVE FOR THE PAST SIX YEARS, TO GRADUALLY GIVE MORE AND MORE DECISION-MAKING RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PEOPLE OF THESE ISLANDS, WHICH HAVE BEEN GOVERNED BY OTHERS FOR OVER 400 YEARS, IN ADDITION TO THE INCREASED POGERS WHICH HAVE BEEN EXERCISED SO CAPABLY BY THE MEMBERS OF THE CONGRESS, WE REACHED A MILESTONE IN LATE 1975 IN OUR MICRONIZATION PROGRAM -- ALL SIX OF OUR PRESENT DISTRICTS ARE HEADED BY MICRONESIAN DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS INDIGENOUS TO THEIR RESPECTIVE DISTRICTS, AND FIVE OF OUR SIX DEPUTY DISTRICT ADMINISTRATORS MEET THE SAME QUALIFICATIONS. WE HAVE REACHED THE POINT WHERE SIX OF OUR EIGHT MAJOR OPERATING DEPARTMENTS ARE HEADED BY MICRONESIANS. YOU CAN REFO ASSURED THAT THIS TREND WILL CONTINUE JUST AS VIGOROUSLY DURING 1976.

"IN ADDITION TO OUR CONTINUED PROGRESS OF PLACING MICRONESIANS IN TOP-LEVEL POSITIONS, WE HAVE GREATLY IMPROVED OUR EMPLOYEE TRAINING PROGRAMS DURING THE PAST YEAR. SECRETARIAL AND CLERICAL SKILLS HAVE BEEN CONSIDERABLY UPGRADED AND, ALTHOUGH MUCH REMAINS TO BE ACCOMPLISHED, WE HAVE MADE SOME PROGRESS IN UPGRADING OUR TECHNICIANS IN PUBLIC WORKS AREAS -- BOTH AT HEADGUARTERS AND, MORE IMPORTANTLY, AT DISTRICT LEVELS. EMPLOYEE TRAINING JILL CONTINUE TO HAVE TOP-LEVEL PRIORITY THROUGH 1976.

"DURING 1975, WE CONTINUED OUR ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN VARIOUS INTERNATIONAL AND INTRA-RAGIONAL ORGANIZATIONS. BEING PARTICULARLY ACTIVE IN THE WORK OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC COMMISSION. IT HAS BEEN MY PRIVILEGE THIS PAST YEAR TO SERVE AS PRESIDENT UF THE PACIFIC ISLANDS DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION. AND I AM PLEASED TO REPORT THAT

WORKING WITH OTHER PACIFIC ISLANDS COUNTRIES, AS WELL AS WITH OUR COLLEAGUES IN HAWAII, GUAM AND AMERICAN SAMOA, WE HAVE MADE CONSIDERABLE STRIDES IN BOTH THE DEVELOPMENT OF OUR PACIFIC AREAS FISHERIES AND, ESPECIALLY, IN THE FIELD OF COOPERATIVE TOURISM FOR THE PACIFIC AREA, WE SHALL BE MEETING AGAIN IN FEBRUARY IN WESTERN SAMOA AND I AM HOPEFUL THAT AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA CAN ACCOMPANY US TO THE MEETING.

"OF GREAT IMPORTANCE TO OUR GROWING TOURISM -- WHICH, INCIDENTALLY, INCREASED BY SOME 9 PERCENT LAST YEAR WHILE OTHER DESTINATION AREAS WERE SHOWING LOSSES -- WAS THE NOVEMBER MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTURS OF THE PACIFIC AREA TRAVEL ASSOCIATION, (PATA) WHICH WAS HELD IN PALAU. THE PEOPLE OF PALAU, ESPECIALLY A GROUP OF STUDENTS FROV PALAU HIGH SCHOOLHAND THE MICRONESCAN OCCUPATIONAL CENTER, ARE TO BE HIGHLY COMMENDED FOR THE TRULY PROFESSIONAL MANNER IN WHICH THEY HANDLED THIS IMPORTANT GATHERING. THE PATA BOARD MEMBERS ALSO MADE A BRIEF, BUT WELL ORGANIZED, VISIT TO YAP FOLLOWING THEIR MEETING IN PALAU.

"PATA IS GENERALLY ACKNOWLEDGED TO BE ONE OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL ORGANIZATIONS OF ITS TYPE ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD, AND HAS HONORED US THIS PAST YEAR NOT ONLY BY HOLDING A BOARD MEETING WITHIN MICRONESIA, BUT BY ELECTING OUR CHIEF OF TOURISM, MIKE ASHMAN, TO ITS BOARD OF DIRECTORS, PATA'S DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY WILL BE ASSISTING US FURTHER BY SENDING A WELL-GUALIFIED GROUP OF EXPERTS TO THE TRUST TERRITORY THIS COMING MARCH.

WREAR ADMIRAL KENT CARROLL, USN, THE NEW CINCPAC REPRESENTATIVE FOR GUAM AND THE TRUST TERRITORY AND COMNAVMARIANAS, HAS JUST COMPLETED A VISIT TO EACH OF OUR SIX DISTRICTS. THIS PERSONAL INTEREST IN. AND FAMILIARITY WITH. OUR PROBLEMS THROUGHOUT ALL OF MICRORESIA WILL CONTINUE. I AM SURE, TO GREATLY BENEFIT THE TRUST TERRITORY.

"CERTAINLY A MAJOR ASPECT OF LIFE IN MICRONESIA DURING THE YEAR JUST PASSED HAS BEEN THE TREMENDOUS AMOUNT OF CRITICISM LEVELLED AGAINST THE TRUST TERRITORY, MAINLY IN THE FORM OF UNPROVEN ALLEGATIONS, BY VICIOUS BUT DEDICATED MALCONTENTS, ALTHOUGH I AM SURE THE MEMBERS OF THIS CONGRESS WOULD JOIN ME IN A FRANK ADMISSION THAT HE ARE ALL HUMAN AND DO FROM TIME TO TIME MAKE HUMAN ERRORS. I THINK YOU WILL AGREE WITH THAT SUCH STRONG WORDS AS "WASTE, " "INEFFICIENCY, " "MISMANAGEMENT" AND EVEN "CORRUPTION" HAVE BEEN USED 50 OFTEN DURING THE PAST YEAR IN RELATION TO TOTALLY UNSUBSTANTIATED AND UNPROVEN ALLEGATIONS THAT THEY MAY EVEN BE BELIEVED BY SOME INDIVIDUALS OUTSIDE THE TRUST TERRITORY. I HUPE THAT THIS BRIEF ERA IS NOW A PART OF OUR PAST AND THAT ALL AMERICANS, AT EVERY LEVEL OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AS THE ADMINISTRERING AUTHORITY, WILL REALIZE FULLY THAT UNDER THE UNITED NATIONS TRUSTEESHIP AGREEMENT OUR ONE TASK IS TO HELP MICRONESIANS AND TO MOVE THEM, AS RAVIDLY AS POSSIBLE, TOWARD BOTH SELF-DETERMINATION AND SELF-SUFFICIENCY. THERE SHOULD BE NO OTHER MOTIVE IN THE MINDS OF ANYONE CONNECTED WITH THE TREMENDOUS RESPONSIBILITY



THEIR EXAMPLE COULD WELL BE FOLLOWED BY OTHER DAILY NEWSPAPERS IN AMERICA AND THRMUGHOUT THE FREE WORLD.

"RECENTLY THERE HAVE BEEN SOME REFERENCES TO THE ALLEGED FAILURE OF "MASSIVE IMPUSIONS OF MONEY INTO THE TRUST TERRITORY." WHILE IT IS TRUE THAT OUR BUDGET THESE PAST FEW YEARS HAS FAR EXCEEDED THAT OF THE FIRST TWENTY YEARS OF THE TRUSTEESHIP, WE SHOULD NEVER LOSE SIGHT OF THE FACT THAT WE ARE ONLY NOW GENUINELY BEGINNING TO REPLACE MANY OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMNETS WHICH WERE DESTRUYED BY THE RAVAGES OF WORLD WAR II. IN THIS CONNECTION, I AM MOST PLEASED TO INFORM THIS CONGRESS THAT, ALTHOUGH IT APPEARED AT ONE POINT THAT OUR FISCAL 1977 BUDGET MIGHT BE DRASTICALLY CUT PRIOR TO BEING SENT TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES, THANKS TO THE TIRELESS EFFORTS OF HR. WE, THEREFORE, WELCOME THE CONTINUING SURVEILLANCE OF THE MEMBERS OF THIS CONGRESS OF THE WORK ACCOMPLISHED OR UNDERTAKEN BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AND ASSURE YOU OF OUR CONTINUED CO OPERATION.

ALTHOUGH HE ABHOY THE WILD AND FANTASTIC MISSTATEMENTS OF SOME VOCAL MALCONTENTS, HE WILL CONTINUE TO SEEK, AND BE RESPONSIVE TO. AND ALL GENUINE CONSTRUCTIVE CRITICISM OF OUR EFFORTS TO MOVE THE TRUST TERRITORY FORWARD. IN THIS CONNECTION, I AM PROUD TO CALL' TO YOUR ATTENTION A REPORT OF DECEMBER 9, 1975, FROM THE FEDERAL COMPTROLLER FOR GUAM AND THE TRUST TERRITORY. IN THIS REPORT ON THE MANAGEMENT AUD IT OF THE HEADQUARTERS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HORKS. THE COMPTROLLER, MR. FLOYD FAGG. POINTS OUT THAT OF BB RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY HIS OFFICE, WITHIN ONE MONTH 35 HAD BEEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED AND 30 OTHERS HERE BEING IMPLEMENTED -- A TOTAL OF 74 PERCENT OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS FULLY OR PARTIALLY IMPLEMENTED WITHIN ONE MONTH DEFINITELY DOES NOT INDICATE AN UNRESPONSIVE ATTITUDE. I CAN ASSURE THE MEMBERS OF THIS CONGRESS, AND ALL OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES. THAT WE WILL PROCEED VIGOROUSLY AND RAPIDLY TO IMPLEMENT ALL SIMILAR MELPFUL RECOMMENDATIONS WHICH WE RECEIVE.

"UNFORTUNATELY, NOT ALL REPORTS ON TRUST TERRITORY OPERATIONS DURING RECENT MONTHS HAVE CONTAINED SUCH CLEARLY DEFINED SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT AS THOSE MADENRY THE COMPTROLLER. AT TIMES, IN FACT, SUCH REPORTS HAVE BEEN SUMEWHAT CONTRADICTORY AND CONFUSING.

"FOR EXAMPLE, WE MAY BE TOLD BY ONE GROUP THAT "SOME OF THE FACILITIES DO NOT SHOW A GREAT DEAL OF ARCHITECTURAL IMAGINATION. THE PLANS HAVE AN INSTITUTIONAL ASPECT AND DO NOT BLEND WELL WITH THE ISLAND ENVIRONMENT." AND A FEW MONTHS LATER OTHERS WHO VISIT THE TRUST TERRITORY ON A SIMILAR MISSION REPORT THAT "ARCHITECTS IN SAIPAN ARE LIVING BEYOND THEIR MEANS AND DESIGNING DREAM CASTLES WITH INSUFFICIENT OR NO FUNDS TO BUILD THEM." SINCE THERE ARE NO MICRONESIAN ARCHITECTS AT PRESENT, THIS IS CERTAINLY AN AREA WHERE WE SEEK AND NEED THE GUIDANCE OF THE ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY AND WE WOULD WELCOME A MORE GENERALLY AGREED-UPON APPROACH TO THE PROBLEM. IT MIGHT ALSO BE NOTED THAT ALTHOUGH SOME REPORTS HAVE BEEN

EXTREMELY CRITICAL OF OUR LACK OF A COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT PLAN, GRAMT FUNDS REQUESTED FOR THIS SPECIFIC PURPOSE WERE DELETED FROM THE TRUST TERRITORY BUDGET REQUEST IN WASHINGTON AND THE ENTIRE FUNDING, OTHER THAN THAT PROVIDED BY THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME, HAD TO COME FROM LOCAL FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA.

"WE DISCUSSED, OF COURSE, TWO POINTS PRESENT IN YOUR MINDS -- YOUR POLITICAL FUTURE AND YOUR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, BUT FOREMOST IN THE PRESIDENT'S MIND -- AND IN MY THOUGHTS ALSO -- WAS THAT YOU, THE PEOPLE OF THESE ISLANDS, BE FULLY CONSULTED ABOUT EVERY STEP WE TAKE IN THESE AREAS.

"WE DO NOT COME HERE TO DAY TO OUTLINE OUR PLANS FOR

"YOU WILL BE BROUGHT INTO THE PLANNING AND DECISION PROCESSES AS FULL AND EQUAL PARTICIPANTS WITH AMERICAN PERSONNEL."

"TO ME THESE IMPORTANT WORDS WERE NOT HOLLOW PHRASES OR WINDOW DRESSING. THEY CONSTITUTED A VERY FIRM STATEMENT OF A NEW AMERICAN POLICY TOWARD MICRONESIA AND ONE WITH WHICH I FULLY AGREE. ANOTHER PALAUAN CONGRESSMAN, ISIDOHO RUDIMOH SAID THE MESSAGE WAS GOOD BECAUSE IT CONTAINS NOT ONLY THE REPORT OF PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT BUT ALSO THE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT WHICH IS VERY IMPORTANT IN THE "MICRONIZATION OF OUR GOVERNMENT."

YAP SENATOR JOHN MANGÉFEL SAID THAT "THE MESSAGE WAS VERY GOOD ALTHOUGH PEOPLE WILL ALWAYS CRITICIZE NO MATTER HOW YOU TRY." HE ADDED THAT SOMETIMES THE POLICY IS GOOD BUT THOSE

WHO IMPLEMENT THAT POLICY "SCREW IT UP."

SENATE PRESIDENT TOSIHO NAKAYAMA OF TRUK SAID OF THE HIGGM'S SPEECH: I HAS PARTICULABLY HAPPY THAT HE QUOTED THE STATEMENT OF FORMER SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR WALTER J. HICKEL SAYING THAT THE PRESIDENT DOES NOT BELIEVE IN THE GOVERNMENT RULING THE PEOPLE BUT RATHER IN THE PEOPLE RULING THE GOVERNMENT.

"TO ME." NAKAYAMA SAID, "THAT STATEMENT OF POLICY IS ONE THAT ALL OFICIALS OF THE ADMINISTERING AUTHORITY MUST BE COGNIZANT OF AND MUST CLOSELY ADHERE TO ITS INTENT AND SPIRIT, AND THAT DEVIATION FROM ITS INTENT AND SPIRIT WOULD CONSTITUTE

A GRAVE VIOLATION OF THE TRUST.

"I AM HAPPY TO NOTE FROM HIS STATEMENT THE LARGE NUMBER OF CASINET POSTS HEADED BY QUALIFIED MICRONESIAN DIRECTORS. I HOPE, HOWEVER, THAT EVERY EFFORT ON THE PART OF THOSE IN AUTHORITY IN HASINGTON D.C. AND MICRONESIA WILL BE LIRECTED TOWARD GIVING THESE MICRONESIAN GENTLEMEN THE UPPORTUNITY AND THE MEANS TO CARRY OUT THEIR DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES AND TO THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA.

"I AM SURE FROM MY PAST AND PRESENT ASSOCIATION WITH MR. JOHNSTON THAT HE SINCERELY MEANT WHAT HE SAID IN HIS REMARKS TODAY WHEN HE STATED: "YOU THE PEOPLE OF MICRONESIA, BECOME THE PROUD GUARDIAN OF YOUR OWN ISLANDS NOW AND FOREVER", AND NI HOPE THE HIGHER UP PEOPLE IN WASHINGTON D.C. SHARE THIS SENTIMENTS," CONCLUDED PRESIDENT NAKAYAMA.
