SUBJECT: 1976 TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL SESSION

1. ON FEBRUARY 25 TRUSTEESHIP COUNCIL (TC) POLITICAL AFFAIRS OFFICER DE COSTA INFORMED MISOFF THAT NO DECISION HAS AS YET BEEN MADE CONCERNING THE DATE FOR THE FORTY-THIRD SESSION OF THE TC. DE COSTA GUESSED THAT IT WILL BE JUNE 21 BUT POINTED OUT THAT THE SESSION COULD START AS LATE AS JULY. SHE SAID THAT THE DECISION WOULD NOT BE MADE UNTIL THE UN VISITING MISSION TO THE TRUST TERRITORY RETURNED TO NEW YORK.

2. ON THE TC PROVISIONAL AGENDA, DE COSTA SAID THAT ANY DECISION ON THAT WOULD ALSO BE HELD IN ABEYANCE UNTIL THE VISITING MISSION RETURNS.

3. IN LIGHT OF LAST YEAR'S DIFFICULTIES IN PUTTING TOGETHER THE BRIEFING BOOK FOR THE TC SESSION, USUN STRONGLY RECOMMENDS THAT ACTION ON THE BREIFING BOOK BE INITIATED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
