A RESOLUTION WHICH PROMPTED A BRIEF DEBATE BEFORE IT WAS ADOPTED WAS ONE EXPRESSING THE APPRECIATION AND SUPPORT OF THE CONGRESS OF MICRONESIA FOR THE PROGRAMS AND SERVICES OF THE TERRITORIAL OFFICE ON AGING, (HJR 6=191).

PONAPE REP. RESIO MOSES EXPRESSED HIS RESERVATION ON THE MEASURE BY SAYING THAT THE AGING PROGRAM DOES NOT HAVE "ANY NEEDS "IN MICRONESIA. THE PROGRAM, ACCORDING TO MOSES, IS NOT "BRINGING ANY GOOD" TO MICRONESIA EXCEPT FOR EMPLOYMENT FOR CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS. "IN MANY CASES, IT INFRINGES UPON THE TRADITIONS," HE ARGUED.

THE PONAPE REPRESENTATIVE SAID THE FEEDING PROGRAM IS "TAKING OVER" FROM THE TRADITIONAL "BUILT-IN SYSTEM" OF TAKING CARE OF ELDERS. "I'M VERY RELUCTANT TO COMMEND THIS KIND OF

REP. HERMAN R. GUERRERO OF THE MARIANAS, SPEAKING IN SUPPORT OF THE RESOLUTION, SAID THAT STEPS ARE BEING TAKEN TO CORRECT THOSE THAT MIGHT INFRINGE UPON THE CULTURES AND TRADITIONS OF MICRONESIANS. HE SAID, IN HIS EXPERIENCE, FROM TRAVELING THROUGHOUT MICRONESIA, HE HAS SEEN ELDERLY PEOPLE SITTING IDLE, DOING NOTHING. THIS KIND OF PROGRAM, ACCORDING TO GUERRERO, WILL MAKE THE ELDERLY PEOPLE MORE "PRODUCTIVE" IN THE SOCIETY.

CONGRESSMAN CHARLES DOMNICK ALSO SPOKE IN FAVOR, "THERE ARE THOSE OF US WHO ARE MODERNIZED TO A POINT WHERE THE ELDERS ARE GOING TO BE A BURDEN ON (SOME PEOPLE) AND THEY DO NOT TAKE CARE OF THEM, "DOMNICK ASSERTED.

THE RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED WITH SEVERAL NEGATIVE

VOTES.

THE SENATE AT ITS EVENING SESSION FRIDAY, DEFEATED A BILL WHICH WOULD AMEND THE EXISTING LAW TO REQUIRE FOR THE PAYMENT

THE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS, CHAIRED BY YAP SENATOR PETRUS TUN SUPPORTED THE PHILOSOPHY BEHIND THE BILL. THEY SAID THE PEOPLE HAVE RESPECT FOR, AND CONSEQUENTLY GET MORE BENEFITS FROM, INSTITUTIONS IN WHICH THEY HAVE A PERSONAL INVESTMENT, THAN INSTITUTIONS IN WHICH THEY HAVE NO SUCH INVESTMENT.

SENATOR OLYMPIO BORJA OF THE MARIANAS STRONGLY OPPOSED THE PASSAGE OF THE BILL, SAYING THAT "IT IS NOT RIGHT TO IMPOSE FEES, ESPECIALLY ON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS."

THE BILL WAS DEFEATED BY A VOTE OF FIVE TO FOUR. SEVEN VOTES ARE NEEDED TO PASS A BILL. VOTING AGAINST ARE SENS. DLYMPIO BORJA, AMBILOS IEHSI, AMATA KABUA, AND LAZARUS SALII. THE SENATE ALSO REFERRED BACK TO THE WAYS AND MEANS
