(2) The Convention shall select, from among its membership, a President and such additional officers as it may deem necessary and appropriate.
(3) The Convention shall adopt its own rules of procedure which shall not be inconsistent with this Act; Provided, however, that no constitutional provision shall be decided affirmatively by the Convention except by the affirmative votes of not less than three-fourths of the delegates present in the Convention; and then no voting except in person shall be permitted.
(4) A quorum shall consist of twenty-eight (28) delegates, provided, however, at least one delegate from each chartered municipality must be present; and provided further that if the Resident Commissioner exercises his discretionary autnority and does appoint additional members from the municipality of Saipan as provided in Section 2(1)(a) of this act, the quorum shall be increased by the number or additional appointees.
(5) The President of the Constitutional Convention, or the Chairman of any duly established committee thereof; shall have the power and authority to issue subpoenas requiring the attendance of witnesses or the production of books, documents, or other evidence, in any matter related to the purpose of the Constitutional Convention. Any
