2. the Convention shall run in the name of the Government of
3. the Northern Mariana Islands, and shall be addressed to
4. any police officer or other duly authorized agent. Such
5. subpoena or other process shall be signed by the President
6. or Chairman, shall contain a reference to this Section,
7. and shall set forth in general terms the matter or
8. questions with reference to which testimony or other
9. evidence is to be taken. Any person to whom the process
10. described in this Subsection is directed, if within this
11. jurisdiction, shall forthwith serve or execute the same
12. upon delivery thereof to him without change or compen-
13. sation; provided, however, that any person serving or
14. executing such subpoena or process shall be compensated
15. for his actual expenses, if any, in connection therewith.
16. (6) The President or the Chairman of any duly established
17. Committee may administer oaths to witnesses in any matter
18. under the examination by the Convention. Every person who,
19. having been as a witness by the Convention to give
20. testimony or to produce papers upon any matter under
21. inquiry before the Convention, refuses to make oath or
22. affirmation, or to answer any question inquiry, shall
23. be guilty of contempt of the Northern Marianas Constitu-
24. tional Convention and upon conviction thereof shall be
25. fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or
